## Art School Supply List for [Course #]: Abstract Painting 2.0 with Linda Montignani

Hi and welcome to Abstract Painting 2.0! In this class we will learn new approaches to seeing abstractly For the first class, please bring a 16" X 20" support to paint on, and all your brushes and painting supplies. See you there!  
Required:

| • Supports, e.g. stretched canvas, canvasboard, gessoed masonite (Home Depot), or Ampersand panels   | 1 – 16" X 20"<br>3 – 18" X 24" up to 30" X 36"        | \$20 - \$30 each (stretched canvas)<br>\$25 - \$120 total (canvasboard)<br>\$28 ea for Ampersand or other panels |
| • Paint – Acrylic, Oil (water soluble or traditional), in whatever colors you have, student grade is OK (if purchasing, suggested colors are Permanent Rose, Quinacridone Rose or Permanent Alizerin Crimson, Cadmium Yellow Pale or Light, Phthalo Blue, Titanium White and Mars Black) | 1 tube each color                                     | \$3.50 - \$8.00 per tube (\$0 - \$40)  |
| • Medium for whatever paint type you are using: Acrylic medium (NOT Gel) can be gloss, satin or matte  | 1 large jar or bottle                                 | \$15 - \$25  |
| • Brushes, filberts, flats, rounds (bring whatever brushes you have appropriate to your paint)   | 2-3 (#8 or 10, #6, #2)                                | \$0 - \$36 or up   |
| • Water/paint containers (margarine, ricotta cheese or other plastic containers for acrylics, metal coffee, tuna or chicken type cans for oils, etc.)  | 4   | \$0  |
| • Spray bottle for acrylics  | 1   | \$2-3  |
| • Wood or other palette OR paper palette OR freezer paper (grocery- with the plastic wrap) – whatever palette type you like to use   | 1 Palette or 1 palette pad or 1 roll of freezer paper | \$0 - \$8  |
| • Containers with lids (Can get at Michael's or Hobby Lobby)   | 5-10  | \$3-5  |
| • Pencil   | 1-2 HB 4-6  | \$0 - \$2  |
| • Eraser, plastic  | 1   | \$1  |
| • Old (or new) charcoal or pencil drawings that you don't mind tearing up  | 2-4, 16" X 20" up to 18" X 24"                        | \$0  |
| • Old but clean rags to wipe out paint   | Several   | \$0  |
| • Small squeegees (or bring some cardboard to cut some)  | Several   | \$3  |
