
## Link to Slide from Courtney and Corey about Preparing Students

## Week 1 & 2

Day 1 - Discuss <u>Roles and responsibilities</u>. Possibly have students define the roles of Facilitator, resource manager, and task manager Play a Kagan strategies game

Day 2 - Setting Behavior Expectations specifically to working collaboratively.

- brainstorm expectations specific to working collaboratively.
- We model situations that may arise. What would happen if....
- This is revisited constantly
  - After every learning activity
  - After every cooperative game
  - Talk about what went well what was successful
  - Talk about what challenges we faced and how we grow from them - what do we need to be successful if we weren't ( see slide 3 for an example on THIS google slide show)



Day 3 - Start off with cooperative learning/classroom culture activity such

as a kagan strategy (short 10mins). Review behavior expectations, review roles, form groups of 3 and assign a role.

Do first of 3 mini projects such as the <u>Paper game</u> while students practice their role (or use this resource or this resource)

Day 4 - Start with cooperative learning/kagan strategy game(10mins). Review as needed. Do 2nd mini project to practice a 2nd role

Day 5 - Start with team building/kagan strategy game(10mins). Review as needed. Do 3rd mini project to practice 3rd role

Day 6 - Intro to <u>Project-based Learning</u> by doing a whole group project. (See <u>checklist for project cycle</u>) As a group Select a topic, write a <u>project proposal</u>.
