FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

How do I find out how my child is doing in a particular class?

You can contact teachers directly or your student's advisory teacher, who serves as the contact for the entire team. You can do this by emailing/calling the teacher directly or calling the main office. If you prefer email, all staff emails can be found at macc.mpschools.org/about/staff-directory. In most circumstances, you can expect to hear back within 24 hours.

The Parent Portal is another way to find out how your child is doing academically in a class. It is an online system you can access to monitor your child's real-time daily attendance, class assignments, and grades. Teachers are required to keep grades updated weekly. Whom do I contact if I have an issue with another student's behavior toward my child or my own child's behavior?

Minneapolis Academy has a dean dedicated to supporting students. Please call the main office to connect to, or leave a message for, your child's dean. In most circumstances, you can expect to hear back within 24 hours.

When can I expect my child's grades to be sent home?

Teachers submit grades at the end of each quarter. Report cards are then generated and mailed home by the District approximately a week after the quarter has ended. To check the calendar for when the quarter ends, please go to: macc.mpschools.org/about/calendar. If you do not receive your child's grades, please call the main office. Parents/guardians can also look up grades using the Parent Portal.

What if I want to visit the school and stop in on one or more of my child's classes – what is your policy?

Parents/Guardians are most welcome to come to the school. We encourage parent involvement and presence. To avoid the disruption that surprise visits can cause, we request parents/guardians pre-arrange teacher visits. ***Because we value safety, all visitors, including parents, must check in at the front desk.***
