Literacy PLD, Impact Ed PLD - Omihi and online

On Friday 9th May, Katie Tullet from Impact Ed led a group of teachers participating in the SAL PLD. During our sessions, we explored the Refreshed English Learning Area, along with the Science of Learning and the Science of Reading and Writing.

We examined a comprehensive, research-based framework for effective literacy instruction and discussed various assessment tools to track progress effectively.
