February 11, 2026

B. Reports

1. Report of the Director of General Education Kaatz noted that 11 courses are not being recertified (on agenda below). He mentioned the updates to the agenda since it was first sent out. There are still 5 proposals outstanding (all THEA or DANC). Those will be handled at the next meeting.

2. Report of Academic Affairs Watnik spoke about increased enrollment in GE 1B and the prospects for dual enrollment in the fall.

1. CS - 230 - Computing and Social Responsibility; Recertification only; Area 4 Ertaul showed an updated syllabus with working links. However, the outcomes for the GE area were not provided. **(M Rowley/S Liberti/P) to conditionally approve upon adding the necessary components of the syllabus.**

2. HOS - 297 - Food & Culture; Recertification only, Area 4/Social Justice. [See note from Catalog here](#) about some Curriculog issues with this course. Kaatz and Padron discussed the Curriculog issue. Watnik apologized for it. Kaatz endorsed the proposal. **(M Kaatz/S Liberti/P) to recertify.**

3. WOST - 101 - Perspectives on Women, Recertification only, Area 4 **(M Liberti/S Rowley/P) to recertify.**

A. **Old Business**

1. [Curriculog Language](#) revision? (make one question instead of two?)
Kaatz outlined the idea from Almeida (linked). Rowley endorsed the idea, and added that eventually syllabi will have the alignment map included. Kaatz suggested providing an example at the next meeting. Liberti encouraged that approach, noting that he could provide that example in materials for faculty, as well.
2. Do we want an alignment map included in Curriculog proposals?

A. Syllabus Policy Discussion (if approved for revised agenda). Rowley suggested that GEOC requirements be explicitly noted in the syllabus policy. She added that GE outcomes should be separate from course learning outcomes on the syllabus. She suggested language such as “alignment maps are strongly encouraged.” Kaatz noted that the policy should state that learning outcomes must match the ones in the policy. Rowley said that due dates, etc. should be required, especially for GEOC courses during certification. Watnik asked about whether chairs need to check every syllabus every term or the check would be during proposal processes. Rowley suggested that for GEOC courses, it might be necessary to look every term. Watnik advocated for having chairs check the syllabus the first time an instructor teaches the course to lighten the load on the chairs.

A. Information Items to GEOC (proposals that were conditionally approved) GEOC was informed. About the MLL courses, the Department Chair (Dennis Chester) acknowledged the removal of repeatability.
