RULES & REGULATIONS	The Tennis Canada Code of Conduct will be enforced. Singles matches will be the best of 3 tie-break sets. Doubles matches will be no-ad scoring with a 10-point match tie-break in lieu of the 3 rd set. Players are required to play singles, with feed-in consolation. Doubles is optional.

DRAW	The public draw will take place 1 April, 4:00 p.m. EST in the Media Room at the Aviva Centre.

The courts are reserved for players in the Qualifications from 7:00am-8:30am on March 31 & April 1. Evening courts are open for reservation on March 31 and April 1, following qualifying matches, at the link below. Times may be changed, depending on match end times. Contact your provincial Resource Person to reserve these online or at the Control Table in the Centre of Excellence; players from ON, QC and AB may reserve their own courts. Morning practice April 2 - 7, from 7:00-8:30am, is divided by province. 30 minute slots may be reserved from 3:00pm the previous day, at the Control Table in the COE. Tennis Canada has the discretion to award direct entries via two avenues: Players enrolled full-time in the NTC or NJTP or players residing and training full-time outside Canada. NJTP players who do not meet their Provinces published wild card criteria and are unable to qualify in their Provinces Junior Nationals qualifying process, due to their participation in an official Tennis Canada Training Camp or on an official Tennis Canada tour, may receive a spot. In addition, players residing & training full-time outside of Canada may be granted an Out of Country spot upon review of their current international performance. Any unused NTC or NJTP spots will be returned to Tennis Canada and not be re-distributed.
