If you can't get to a website	Check to see who the filter thinks you are. <u>Click HERE for instructions</u>






New Google Docs Feature

Go to More Options to set other options.




Bitmoji Extension for Feedback



Copy/Download Images from a Google Doc.

There are time when I would like to copy an image from an existing Google Doc. Right clicking and copy does not work within Google docs. But you can download all the images from a doc all at once.

- Go to File
- Download as
- Web Page (Html, zipped)
- This will create and download a zipped file that contains all the images from that document.



This is helpful if you want to use images from that document in other applications.
