
Coaching Corner


Has your student shared that they often work with a partner or in a group during the day for a variety of curricular tasks?

Collaboration and parallel sharing are not the same thing but often get merged as such when students are working in groups. Collaboration involves the generation of collective knowledge through building off of one another's ideas, challenging each other's thinking, and bringing in perspectives that would not be considered if students were working on their own. Parallel sharing is when kids do their own thinking and then compare answers, or split the problem into parts and then have each member of the group work independently on an assigned part. Milford teachers are focused on creating the conditions for the former, true collaborative thinking. Groups coupled with guidance from the teacher allows a shift towards students listening to each other and building on each other's ideas--to shift towards true collaboration.
