Overseas/Student Membership Policy

1. Purpose

Les Mielles Tennis Club recognises that some members spend extended periods living overseas but wish to remain part of the LMTC community. The Overseas and Student Membership category is designed to provide a flexible option for those who primarily reside abroad while maintaining a connection to the Club during visits to Jersey.

2. Eligibility

To qualify for Overseas Membership, applicants must:

- Have their primary residence outside Jersey.
- Reside overseas for a minimum of six (6) months per calendar year.
- Spend no more than 8-12 weeks on the island in one continuous period.
- Provide reasonable proof of overseas residence if requested.
- Be approved by the Committee.

To qualify for Student Membership, applicants must:

- Provide proof of Student status (ID)

The Committee reserves the right to review eligibility annually.

3. Membership Rights & Access

Overseas Members may:

- Book and use club courts while visiting Jersey, in accordance with LMTC booking rules.
- Participate in social tennis sessions and internal club events (subject to availability).
- Attend club social events at member rates.
- Receive club communications and updates.

Overseas Members may not:



- Vote at the Annual General Meeting or Extraordinary General Meetings.
- Stand for or hold Committee positions.
- Represent the Club in official league or inter-club competitions (unless approved by the Committee).

4. Usage Guidelines

Overseas Membership is intended for temporary visits only.

- Court use is expected to be limited to short stays during visits to Jersey.
- Members spending extended continuous periods on-island (for example more than 8–12 weeks in a membership year) may be asked to transfer to an appropriate full membership category.

5. Fees

- The Overseas Membership subscription will be set annually by the Committee.
- The fee will reflect reduced on-island usage compared to full membership.
- The fee will be set at 70% of the relevant annual membership
- Subscriptions are payable in full at the start of the membership year.

6. Coaching & Programmes

Overseas Members may:

- Book private coaching sessions (subject to availability).
- Participate in club camps or organised activities during their time on-island.

Certain performance programmes or team training may require full membership.

7. Code of Conduct

All Overseas Members are required to comply with LMTC's Constitution, Club Rules, Safeguarding Policies and Code of Conduct.

The Club reserves the right to withdraw Overseas Membership status where eligibility criteria are no longer met or where club policies are breached.

8. Policy Review



This policy will be reviewed periodically by the Committee to ensure it remains fair and aligned with the best interests of the Club and its members.
