

Field Setup

Team Benches and Spectator Areas

- Each field has **team benches** provided for both teams. They are already set up, please **do not move them**. Only team coaches/managers/players are allowed to use benches. In front of each team bench is considered the **substitution zone**.
- **Spectators are asked to sit next to their team**. Due to the close proximity of the fields, this means spectators from the adjacent field will be back to back with other teams/spectators.
- Keep chairs in an even row (this will also help prevent the ball from going over to next field). Keep in mind that players will need room to take kick-ins, so no chairs tight on the line.

Fenced Area = No spectators

- NO spectators are allowed to set up behind the goals where the backstops are. Please do NOT use this as a walkway between fields during games.
- Each team can provide one or two individuals to help **shag balls in this area** and prevent them from going onto neighboring fields. Perfect for responsible siblings. Follow the instructions of the ref and do not interfere with the play of any game.
- After your game ends please move off the field quickly to let the next team/spectators set-up.

Open/Community Areas:

- Please do not set up canopies/tents in the areas between the fields and paved walkways. The back stadium field/track area is open space and the back perimeter of the HS area (by the trees) is open space. Any team/club is welcome to set up tents and areas for players/coaches to get out of the sun/rain to rest. Please just keep trash picked up..
