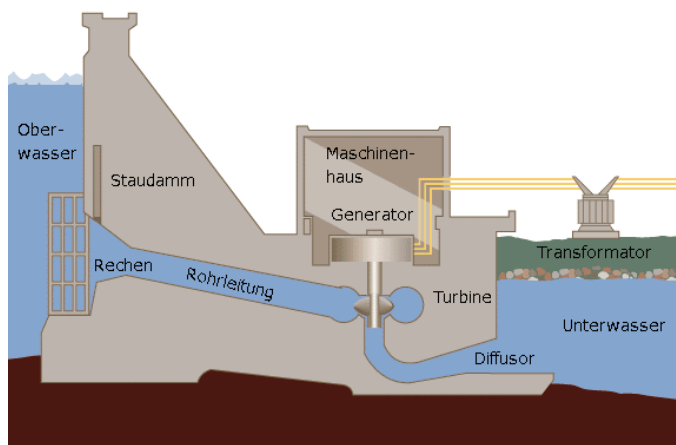


The Pollution of hidropower plants

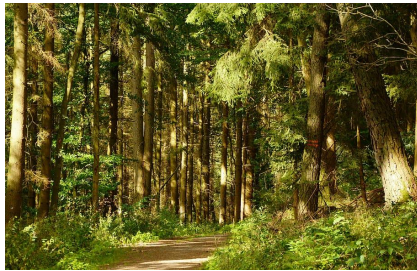
Protecting the environment

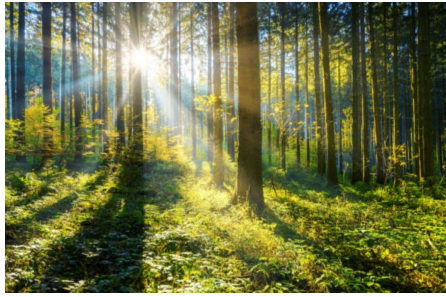
Protect the forests!

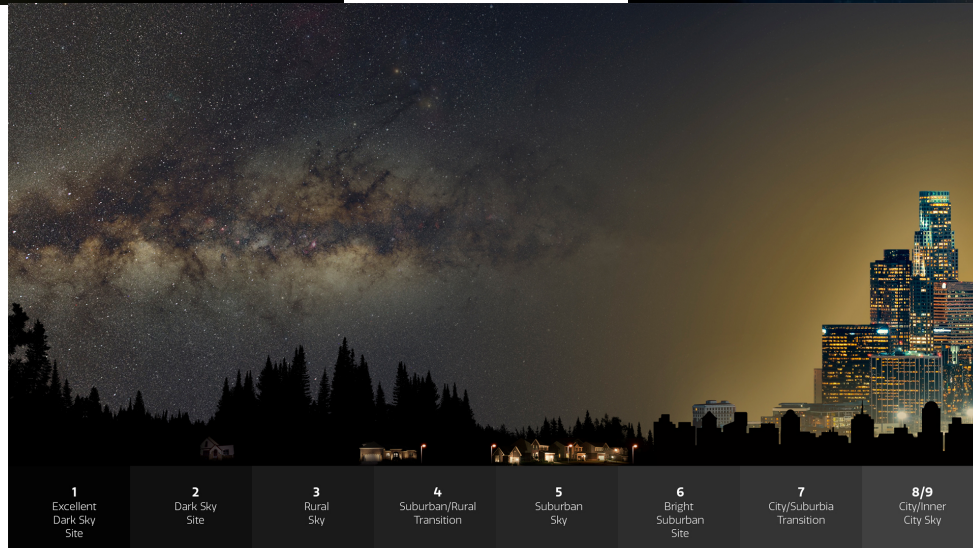
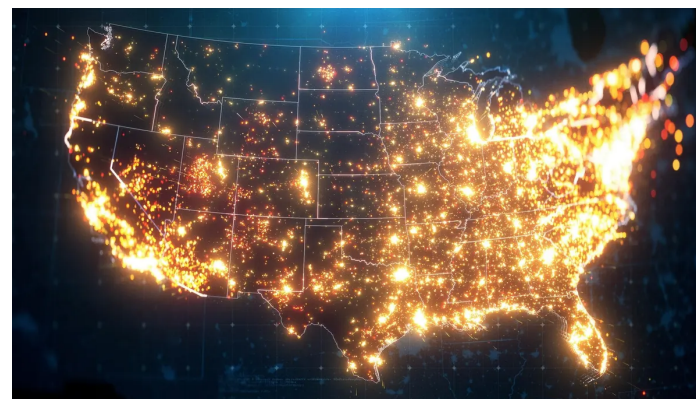
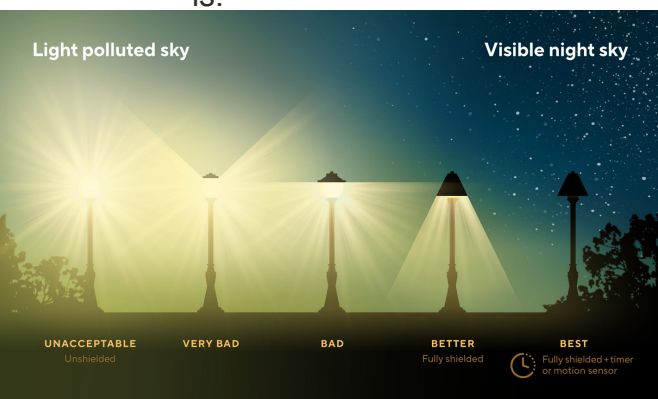
Light Pollution

Light pollution is the presence of unwanted, inappropriate, or excessive artificial lighting. Light pollution affects how we see the night sky, due to a lot of artificial lighting, such as street lights, interfering with how bright the stars seem to our eyes.

A way we can stop light pollution is by trying to use less artificial light, such as turning on less light bulbs when inside, and by refraining from using headlights when driving, as long as you can see ahead.

Some streetlights are designed in a way that seriously contributes to light pollution, like being a big lightbulb with no cover on top, which sends unnecessary light towards the sky. Our streetlights point downward, which wastes less energy by needing to use less light, and doesn't send excess light upward.
