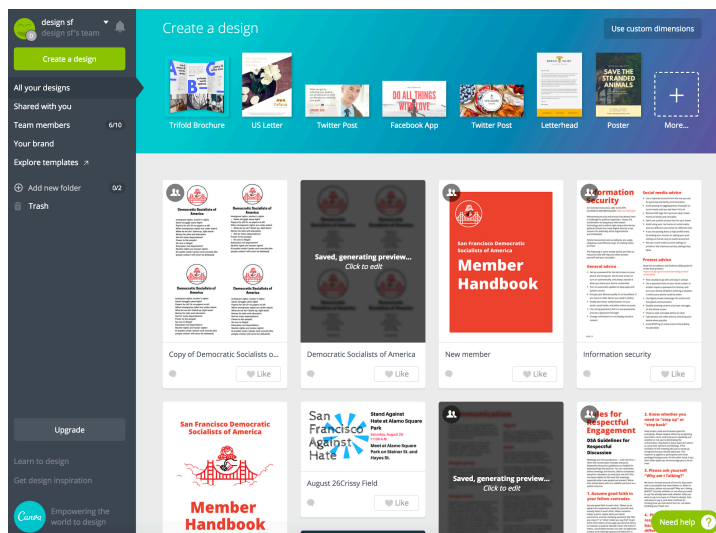

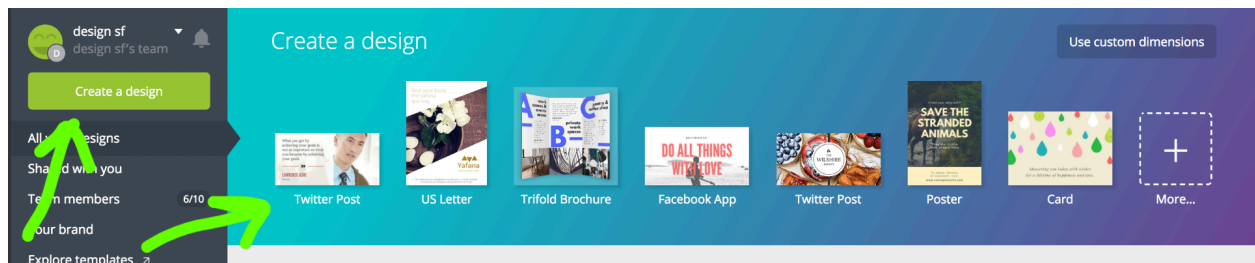
## Step 1: sign up for a free canva.com account

Canva is a free graphic making tool that anyone can use to make fast, professional looking graphics.



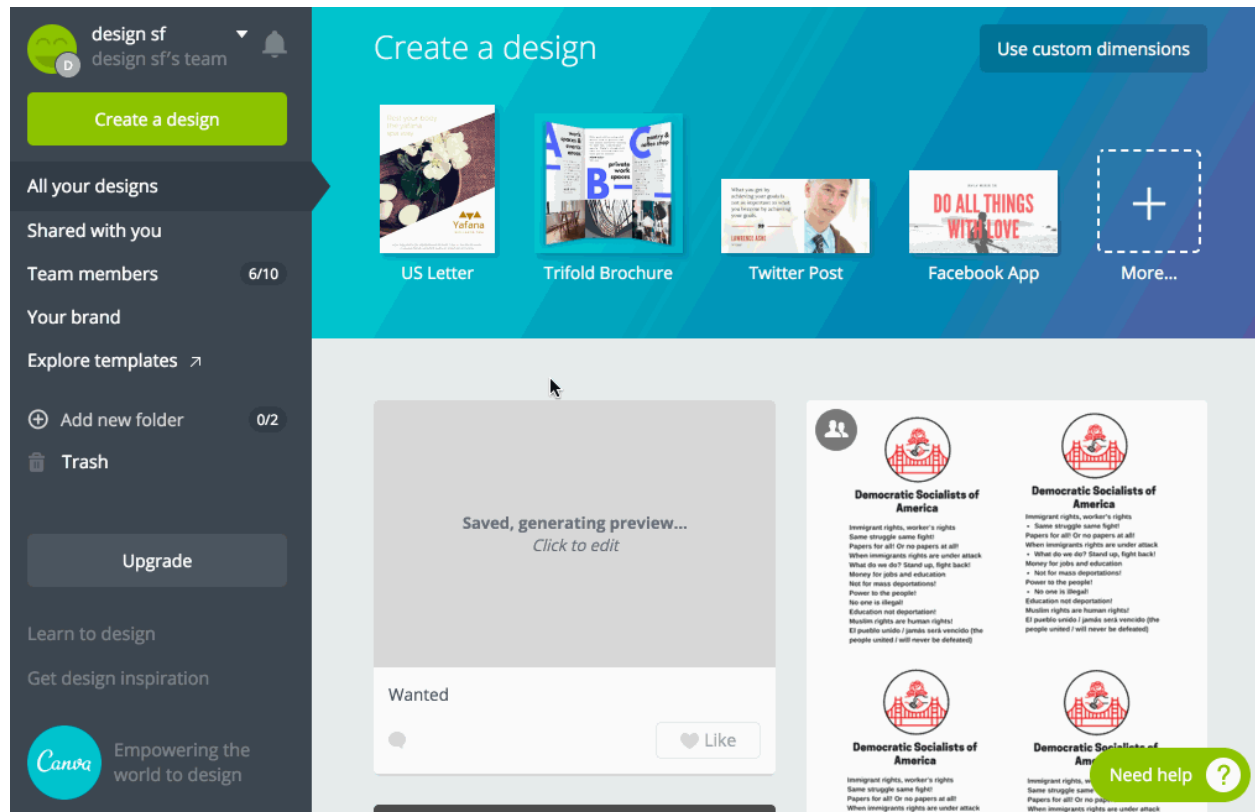
## Step 2: Create a design

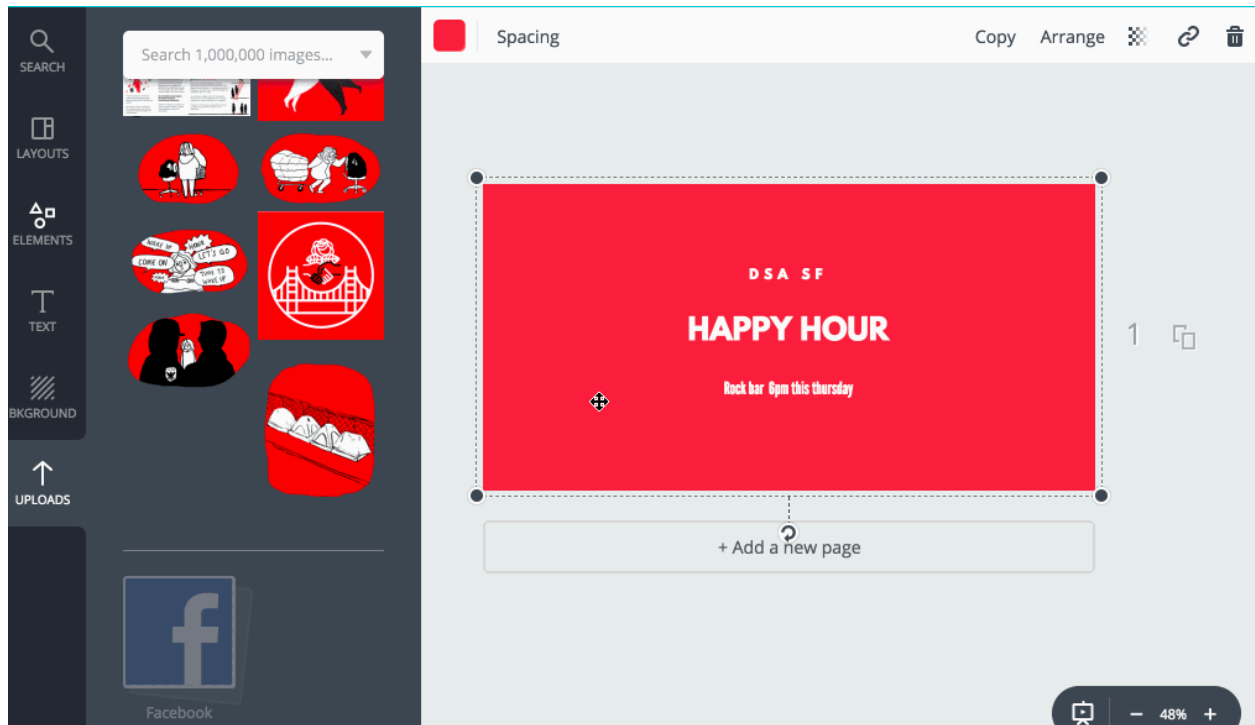
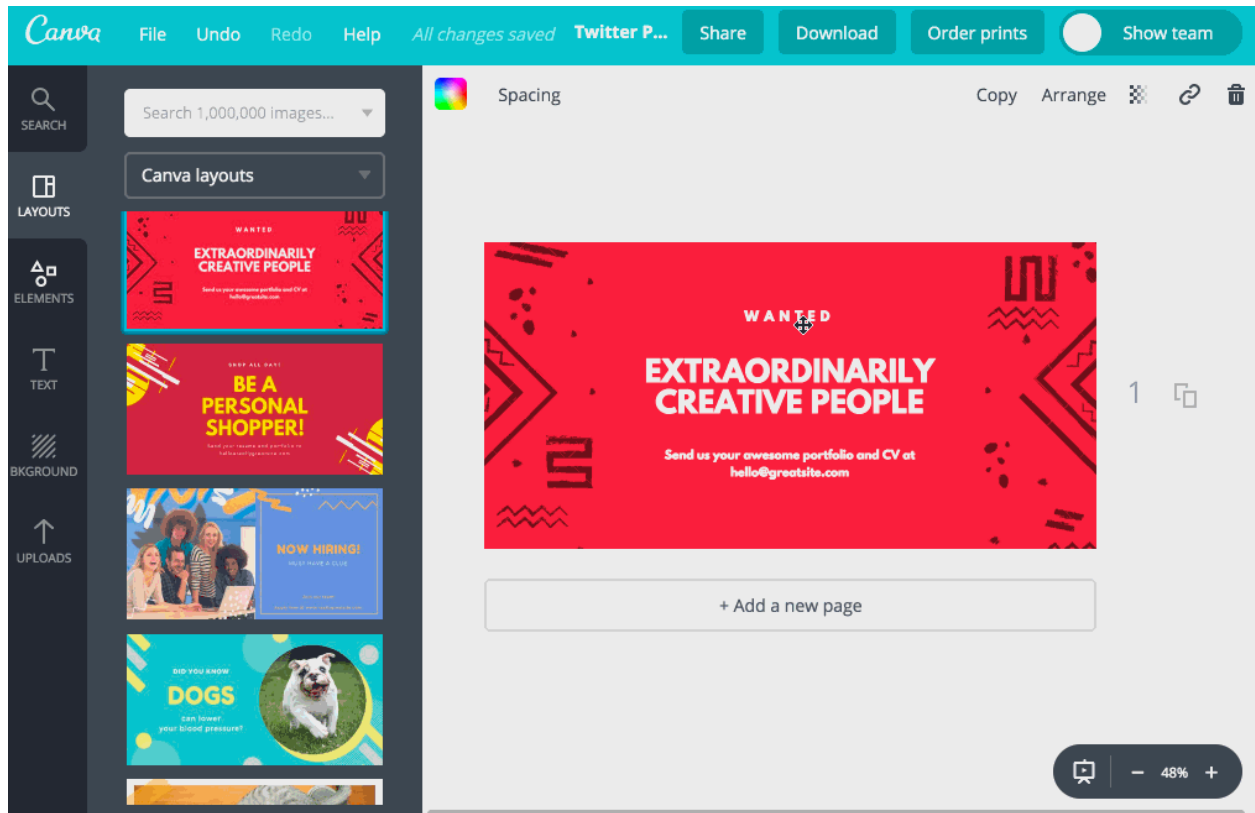
Start by clicking the green button or choose from any of the “quick launch” options at the top.



# Step 3: Start from a template or start from scratch

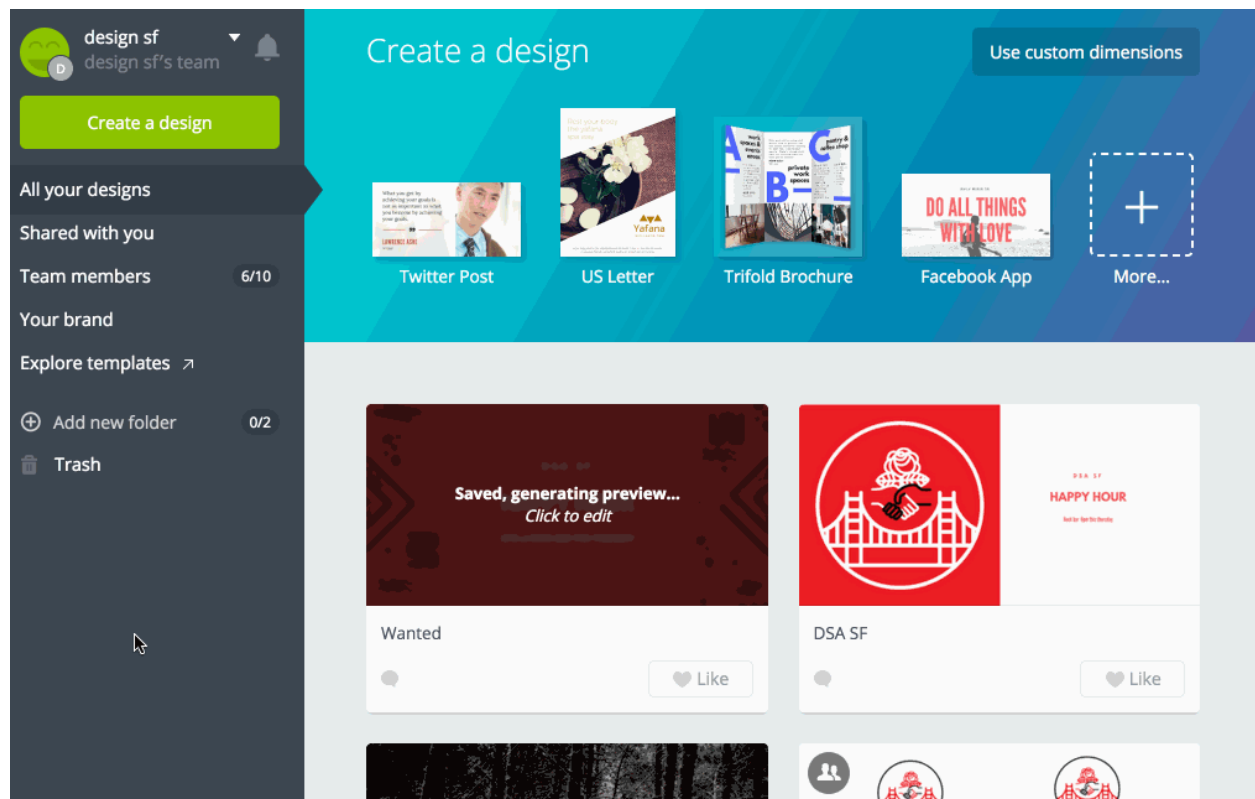
I usually start from a template and edit it.

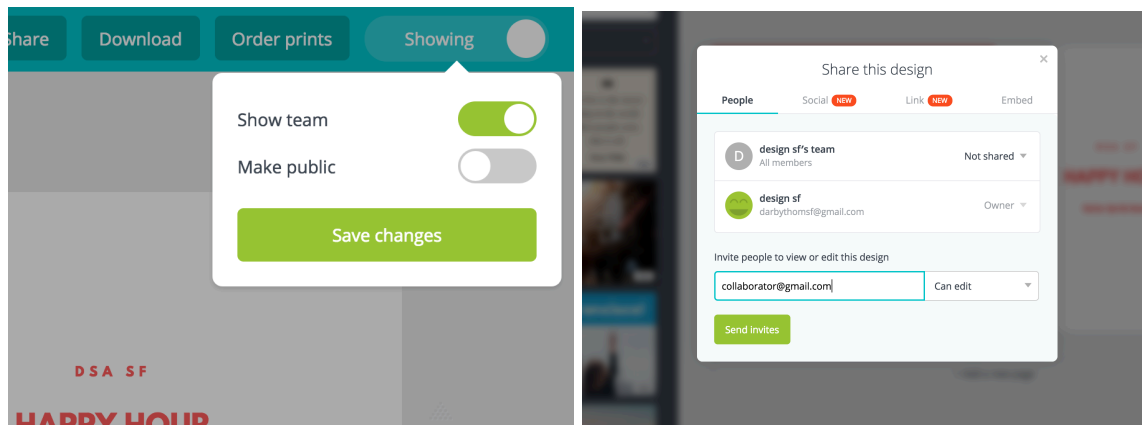




# How to upload your own graphics:

1. Get files you need from here and save them to your computer:

2. Click the 'uploads tab'
3. Upload them. You'll be able to access these graphics forever now!





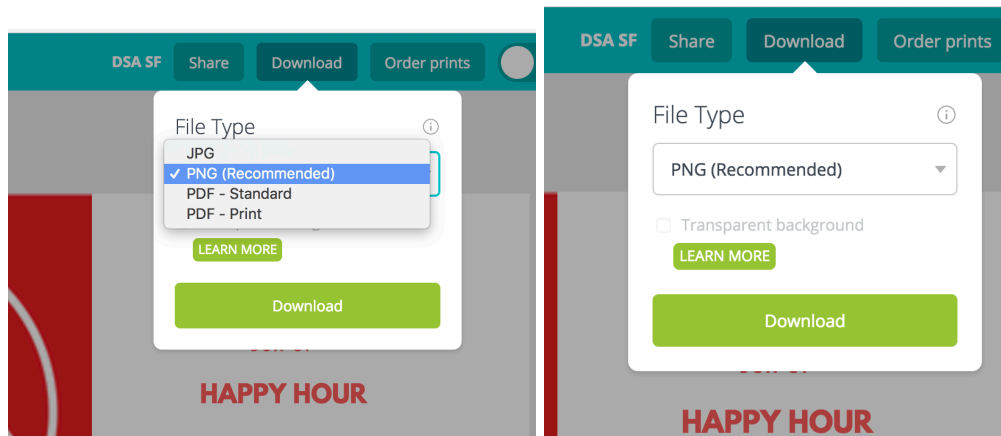
## How to download

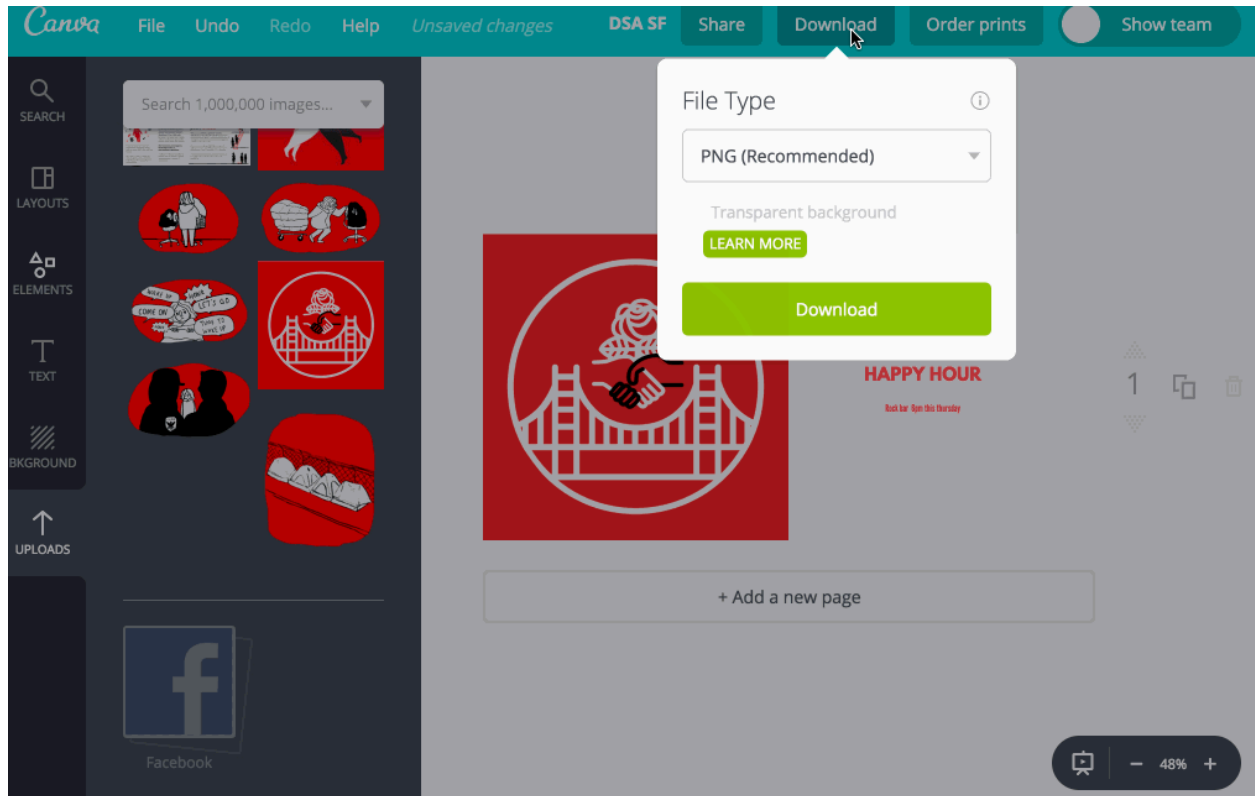
USE PNG: If the graphic will be distributed and viewed only on the web

USE JPG: If the graphic is mostly a photograph

USE PDF - Standard: If the graphic or document will be distributed and viewed only on the web

USE PDF - Print: If the graphic will be printed





## Tips for printing

Will you be printing this with the office printer? Here's some advice

1. Make "low ink" designs:
  - a. Don't use color backgrounds
  - b. Avoid photographs
2. Make a design that will look good in black and white. We are always out of toner.
  - a. Use high contrast colors
