

Instructions for Online Course Selection

These instructions will help guide you through the process of selecting your courses for the following school year.


Each grade level has different subject areas they must make a selection in to be able to make the final submission. You will find the grade level courses after the instructions. The course selection window closes on February 1, 2026. Please pick your courses and submit them through PowerSchool prior to the end of the day on the first.

Step 1 – Review Course Offerings

You can find this information on the [Course Registration](#) page of the HHS website. Feel free to use the course catalog, elective options, and/or the course pick sheet to review what is available.


Step 2 – Login to your Power School student account

1) Select “Class Registration” from the left side

2) Each grade level (9-12) will look slightly different. To register for a class in a specific area, click on the tiny box with the pencil icon in it. This might be located below the subject name or to the right side of the screen.

3) After opening a subject area, select the specific course by clicking the box towards the left and then hitting “Okay” at the bottom of the open window when done. Remember, many of the subject windows have multiple pages. Options are in alphabetical order.

4) After you click “Okay” you should see your selection next to or below the subject.

5) After all courses have been selected, click submit at the very bottom of the page on the right. If it will not allow you to submit a small box should pop up telling you which course is the issue. Usually it is because you tried to change a class that was already entered for you, due to the Accelerated Placement Act, or because you signed up for a class you did not meet the prerequisite for. Another issue could be that you did not select something from all of the categories required for your grade level.

Summer School Courses:

Summer school information usually becomes available towards the end of March. You cannot select summer school courses through this process. If you plan on taking one of the courses required through the course selection process over the summer, you must select it now, and it will be removed from your courses once you have received a spot in the summer school course.

Waiving PE:

If you are waiving PE for Marching Band or a varsity level sport, select PE for course selection, and fill out the PE waiver form on the Course Registration page on the HHS website.

YEAR LONG ELECTIVES FOR SENIORS Select a combination of year long, semester, and/or MCC electives to complete your schedule. HHS does not permit a partial day schedule so you will need to make sure you have enough courses selected to fill up the full eight period school day.

SEMESTER ELECTIVES FOR SENIORS You are only allowed to take one non credit bearing course. Please only select one self guided study hall, early release or late arrival per semester if you are choosing to take one. You are not able to take more than one of those options per semester.
