



This project is a cross that was supposed to have a drawing and verse on it but I couldn't find a verse that summed up the project. I got this idea from a bible study I was doing and it inspired me to make this. I chose to make it realistic because the cross is made out of wood so it is pretty realistic. I hope the viewers see that it is a scrappy piece of work, but also have certain elements that connect it to a more earthen piece.

I worked with wood, hot glue but it never stuck because of the older pieces of wood so they would fall apart, and an old tennis shoe lace to hold it together. One of the challenges was that

the hot glue wasn't sticking the two pieces of wood together so I had to grab an old shoe lace and use it to keep the two pieces together. The successful parts were the shoelace and the pieces of wood. The wood was just right because the leg was a long piece so it would be able to hold the other piece, the other piece was a bit shorter and wider. This worked because if i had found a verse, i could have written it out and drawn on the piece. The shoelace came in and helped hold the two pieces together when the hot glue failed. I am not as happy with it because I feel like it could have been better if I had found a verse to use with the piece. I discovered that if a wood piece is older then hot glue will not stick to it and you will have to find a different way to keep them together.
