Keywords: Consists of 5 words (Font Times New Roman, size 9, spasi 1, justify)

INTRODUCTION

Double Space

The introduction contains the research background concisely, concisely, and clearly; problem formulation, research objectives; as well as data related to the substance of the study. Does not contain many references, except those of a regulatory nature, laws, regulations, and the like. Writing narratively, does not need to be given special sub-titles. Included in writing operational definitions, if deemed necessary, are also written narratively. (Font Times New Roman, size 11, spasi 1,15 justify)

Research methods contain the type of research, sample and population or research subject, time and place of research, instruments, research procedures and techniques, as well as other matters related to the way of research. This section can be divided into subchapters, but it is not necessary to list the numbering. (Font Times New Roman, size 11, spasi 1,15 justify)

This section contains data analysis and interpretation of the results. Results can be presented with tables or graphs to clarify the results verbally because sometimes the appearance of an illustration is more complete and informative than the display in the form of a narrative. This section must answer the problem or research hypothesis that has been formulated previously. (Font Times New Roman, size 11, spasi 1,15 justify)

For tables, the table description is placed at the top of the table. The caption is written in the center with a distance of 1 space from the table. Like the image caption, the table caption is also given a sequence number. Table source writes are placed below the table. (Font Times New Roman, size 11, spasi 1, justify)

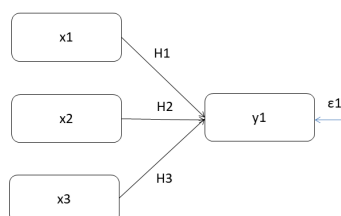

Equation numbers are written in parentheses placed on the right of the equation and aligned with the right margin. An example of a writing formula is as follows:

$$Y = a + bx_1 + bx_2 + e \quad (1)$$

CONCLUSION*Enter 1x*

The conclusion must be related to the title and answer the formulation or purpose of the study. Do not make statements that are not adequately supported by your findings. Write down improvements made to industrial engineering or science in general. Do not make further discussions, repeat abstracts, or just list the results of the study. Don't use bullet points, use paragraph sentences instead. (Font Times New Roman, size 11, spasi 1,15 justify)

Contains a thank you to sponsors who have supported your publication. (Font Times New Roman, size 11, spasi 1, justify)

*Enter 3x***REFERENCES**

This section contains only references to which it is actually referenced. Thus, references entered in this section will be found written in the preceding sections. Writing a bibliography consists of the author's name, year of publication, article title, city name and publishing institution. The bibliography is sorted according to the first letter of the author's name (A-Z), not necessarily grouped by book, journal, newspaper, or by other types of publications. Written with a space of 1. If in 1 reference more than one line, then the second line and so on are made indented. The bibliography is preferably articles taken from the latest journals or publications. The systematics of writing is as follows: (Font Times New Roman, size 11, spasi 1, justify).

References are required to use the Mendeley application. The references style refers to the 6th edition of the APA (American Psychological Association) system, where the last name or surname (surname) is placed in front, while the first name (one or two words) is sufficient to write the initials and placed behind the family name, separated by a comma.

Systematics of writing for articles and the internet:

Author name *reversed. Year of publication. *The title of the writing*. [Online] Available: site address. [date, month, year access]

Notes:

1. Manuscripts sent that do not match the format/template will be immediately rejected
2. Margin standard (top 2.5, bottom 3.0, right 2.5, left 3.0)
3. Black letter/text color
4. Distance 1,15 space, then setting the menu Font-Advanced spacing condensed 0.3 pt
5. Layout before-after 0 pt
6. Times New Romance font
7. Font size manuscript 11
8. Font size of table and figure headings 11
9. Font size of table contents and figure 11
10. 10 header and footer font size with Times New Romance font
11. Distance between paragraphs (spacing before and after) = 0
12. Distance between subchapters or sections 1x enter
13. Number of pages 10-15 pages
14. Do not use numbering, other than problem statement numbers, discussion and conclusions. Example: 1. aaaaa; 2. bbbbb; 3. CCCC; and so on
15. If it is necessary to use numbering, use numbering that is different from the formulation, discussion and conclusion. Examples: a) ppppp; b) qqqqq; c) rrrrr; and so on
16. Bibliography using the style of the American Psychological Association (APA) 6th edition.
