Discussion

Subtitles

Filled with the substance of the study conducted and the analysis of the study according to the concept or theory used.

The author's analysis must also appear in the discussion so that the author's analysis is clearly illustrated regarding the results of the study made

Substance of Theoretical Studies,

Contains the theories and concepts used so that they can be used as a basis for analysis of the results of the studies that will be made.

Footnote

Each time quoting an opinion, the author must give a footnote using Format Chicago Manual of Style 17th Edition (full note). Please use Mendeley or Zotero manager reference app.
