Local Recognition through Longmont High:

LHS Advanced Placement Diploma Requirements

1. Students must take five year - long AP courses (or the equivalent) in at least four subject areas. The subject areas are **Art, Music, Computer Science, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Language Arts, and World Language.**
2. Students must complete these five AP courses with **no grade lower than a B.**
3. Students **must** take the AP test in each AP course that counts as a subject area requirement.
4. Students must submit an application for the Longmont High School AP Diploma in the year in which they intend to graduate. **Applications will be available in the Counseling Office mid-March and must be returned by the last school day in April.**

National Recognition through Collegeboard:

AP Scholar

- Granted to students who receive scores of 3 or higher on three or more AP Exams.

AP Scholar with Honor

- Granted to students who receive an average score of at least 3.25 on all AP Exams taken, and scores of 3 or higher on four or more of these exams.

AP Scholar with Distinction

- Granted to students who receive an average score of at least 3.5 on all AP Exams taken, and scores of 3 or higher on five or more of these exams.

State AP Scholar

- Granted to the one male and one female student in each U.S. state and the District of Columbia with scores of 3 or higher on the greatest number of AP Exams, and then the highest average score (at least 3.5) on all AP Exams taken.

National AP Scholar

- Granted to students in the United States who receive an average score of at least 4 on all AP Exams taken, and scores of 4 or higher on eight or more of these exams.
