How to Add the Zoom App to a Chromebook

Note - Zoom cannot be added from a STCC Gmail account because we do not manage the accounts. A personal Gmail account will need to be used. If you do not have a personal Gmail account, you can create one for free by going to Gmail.com and Sign up.

• How to install zoom if no one else has signed onto the Chromebook (VIDEO)

On the main login screen, sign in with your personal Gmail address.

Click the play store APP in the lower taskbar.

Search for "Zoom PWA" and install.

• How to install if another email has signed onto the Chromebook:

On the main login screen, select "add person" then sign in with your personal Gmail address. Click the play store APP in the lower taskbar.

Search for "Zoom PWA" and install.

How to access the Zoom App after installing it (VIDEO)

Click on the circle in the lower left corner of the screen.

Open the "all apps" menu.

Find the Zoom App and launch it.

Add zoom to your STCC Gmail by linking the accounts: (VIDEO)

Click on the circle in the lower left corner of the screen.

Click the up arrow above the search bar and "all apps" will display.

Click the "settings" App.

On the left menu, click "accounts" and "currently signed in as (your name)".

Click the option to "add a google account".

Follow the process to add your STCC Gmail address.

• Zoom will need to be added for each individual account on the Chromebook.

How to clear accounts on the Chromebook (this may be needed periodically):

From the Main screen press "ctrl + Alt + Shift + r".

Click Restart.

Once the computer reboots you will see the "reset Chromebook" page.

Click the "powerwash" button.

Once this is done you can continue to add accounts.
