Eligibility

- Positions

 - Heads of Special Education Services
 - Early Learning Centre Managers
 - Deputy Principals
 - Campus/School Principals
- Self-nominations are not eligible

Nominator & Endorsement

- One nominator required from colleagues, department heads, level leaders or principals.
- The nominated teacher's school principal/head of campus/deputy will be notified to verify the bona fides of the supporting information.

Criteria

The recipient of the Leadership Impact Award will:

- Lead in mentoring staff, parents, carers, and the broader school community to cultivate a professional culture focused on nurturing student faith and supporting their learning development.
- Plan and implement meaningful programs and initiatives that drive high-quality professional learning and research, effectively responding to the diverse needs of students within their educational context.
- Actively engage in professional collaboration with colleagues, parents, carers, and the wider school community, ensuring that learning is engaging, visible, innovative, and service-oriented, all while aligning with the mission and values of a Seventh-day Adventist school.
