Transcript Evaluation- Addictions Practitioner Application

Other applicants with baccalaureate degree programs in a mental health discipline with concentration in addictionology, chemical dependency, or substance abuse, with twenty-one (21) semester hours of coursework (either graduate or undergraduate) completed in each of the core areas defined herein. A course may not be used to satisfy more than one area. (3 semester credits = 4 quarter credits.)
