How do we work with families?

- Welcoming their voices with open arms
 - Bi-weekly/Monthly Town Halls
 - Spaces for schools to provide updates, answer questions, and hear concerns and suggestions.
 - True North Council

- A council composed of Parents/Guardians, school leaders and Network Staff.
 - Nurturing our parent/guardian leaders and providing a platform for them to use their presence and their voices in our schools and in their communities.
- Meeting families where they are and encouraging them to take the ride with us.
 - We accommodate for families who speak a primary language outside of English.
 - Spanish interpreters at every campus
 - Communication delivered in their preferred language
 - We don't assume we know things. We approach all families with the intent to help.
 - Practice priority hiring of parents/families in network paraprofessional, and operational roles.
- Taking the time to listen
 - Teachers and staff call and check in to assess for needs outside of school
- Thinking outside the box
 - Problem solving through village meetings
 - Creative solutions for families with extensive needs that may be preventing children from getting to school
- We don't give up on them
 - o Multiple calls, emails, home visits for families who disengage
