for PfISD Chromebooks

The Secure Test Browser for state assessment programs is preinstalled on all PfISD Chromebooks, and <u>no further actions is required</u>.

Students will turn on the device and select "SecureTestBrowser" from the Apps menu.

Students will not sign in to the Chromebook to access the secure browser for state assessment programs.


Online Testing Setup

for PfISD desktops & laptops (excluding Chromebooks)

Username – Testing

Password – Success!

Installation is only required if a campus is using Windows desktops and/or laptops for the administration of state assessments. If a campus is only using Chromebooks for state assessments, no further action is required.



Login with the username and password noted above.


Let the computer start up and wait 10-15 minutes.

Double click the "Gpupdate" (green arrow) on the desktop. Follow any on screen prompts.

Open "Install Software" to install "Cambium Secure Browser - Setup" for Version 18-0. (Must be logged in to "Testing" user account. See above.)

You may be prompted to restart the computer.

The "TxSecureBrowser" icon will be available on the desktop.

For 2025-2026, Version 18-0 must be manually installed.

If you don't see the icon, follow the installation instruction to the left.

The exact location of the icon will vary on each desktop.
