Dear Parent/Guardian:

In order to keep things consistent in September with respect to supplies, below is a list of **SUGGESTED** supplies for the beginning of the **2025-2026** school year.

Entering Grade 1

- 16 Glue sticks, small, washable, dries clear (ex. Elmer's purple glue stick-clear drying)
- 3 2-Pocket folders, **plastic coated, (red with clasps, green with clasps, yellow without clasps)**
- 2 Marble composition notebooks, any color, **wide rule**, 100 pages, 9 ³/₄" x 7 ¹/₂"
- 4 Rectangular or square erasers
- 4 Yellow highlighters
- 8 EXPO dry erase markers, **black, fine tip**
- 2 Boxes of tissues
- 4 Packs Post-It notes, 3" x 3", 100 sheets each pack
- 3 Boxes of Ticonderoga Pencils, #2, yellow, **sharpened**, 12 count
- 1 Headphones in plastic bag Ziploc bag labeled with student first and last name, please no wireless headphones
- 2 Box of Crayola crayons, 24 count
- 1 Box of Crayola markers, 10 count, washable broad-line markers
- 1 Backpack large enough to accommodate books, notebooks, lunch box, etc.
- 1 Container of Clorox wipes
- 1 Roll of paper towels
- 1 Box of Ziploc bags (any size)

For Spanish Class

- 1 2-Pocket folder (pockets at the bottom, not side)

A Note about Snacks: Healthy, non-sweet snack and drink from first day until end of school (parent/guardian option). **Important:** Snack should be packed separately from lunch, in an individual bag or container. Child's name and/or number (assigned on the first day of school) should be written on snack.

A Note about Personal Belongings: Please use a permanent marker to identify your child's belongings. Write the name or number (assigned on the first day of school) on everything that comes to school from the first day to the last day of school. For example, write "John Doe" on the tissue boxes, jacket label, lunch box, etc.
