I. Call to Order & Welcome The meeting commenced with greetings to all members present.

II. Reports

- **Budget Report:** Site Council members were presented with a report detailing the current balance amounts for the selected budgets.

III. New Business / Action Items

- **Motion: 5th Grade Visit Transportation**
 - **Details:** A motion was made to approve an amount not to exceed \$1,500 to cover the cost of buses for Hopi and Tavan Elementary Schools for the 5th-grade trip. It was noted that Ingleside covers these expenses every other year.
 - **Vote:** The motion was approved unanimously.
- **Motion: 8th Grade Washington D.C. Trip Support**
 - **Details:** A motion was made to approve an amount not to exceed \$2,000 to cover the cost of substitute teachers for staff members chaperoning the 8th-grade Washington D.C. trip.
 - **Vote:** The motion was approved unanimously.

IV. Discussion Items

- **Campus Improvements (Trees & PTO Area)**
 - The Council reviewed updated quotes for planting trees and installing water lines to the PTO area.
 - Discussion followed regarding the potential for securing better pricing through donations or vendors outside of the standard district-approved list.
- **School Repurposing & Community Impact**
 - The Council discussed ongoing conversations regarding district school repurposing efforts.
 - Key topics included the potential impact on surrounding communities and the Ingleside community specifically.
