# Appendix:

Making mistakes is absolutely fine, we encourage officers to act only how they think is best and to demonstrate how they operate as an officer. However, intentionally disruptive behaviour WILL Lead to a kick from the session and potential punishments. (All Policies Still Apply)

This session we will be offering candidates a retry for each stage. This is likely to change depending on the situation or the time that has already elapsed.

Stage 1: Bank Robbery

**Description:** You will be told to patrol around the city, before being alerted over radio that a bank robbery has begun by dispatch and are expected to respond code 3 and deal with each situation to the best of your abilities.

# What we expect from you (method of dealing with the situation)?

- > Respond to the bank robbery code 3 using lights and sirens with safe and efficient responsive driving.
- Take care when responding, insuring your own, partner and any other officers safety making sure not to alert bank robbers until backup arrives.
- > With good observation skills and situational awareness. Take note of any active shooters and potential flankers, relaying information over radio to your fellow officers.
- > If possible create a perimeter of the bank with fellow officers before entering at the same time.

# Potential Good Observations / skills demonstrated:

- > Responsive Driving
- > Communication
- > Situational Awareness
- > Observation
- ➤ Leadership

## **Potential Bad Observations / Misconducts:**

- Shooting Violations
- ➤ Use Of Force
- > No Communication
- ➤ Unprofessionalism when in stressful situations
- > Confiscating

**Stage 2:** Open incident in Bazaar.

## **Description:**

You will be patrolling around the city when alerted of an emergency message regarding possible break in at Bazaar. On arrival, you will witness multiple armed and possible suspects. Maintain a high level of focus and perform to the best of your abilities.

## What we expect from you (method of dealing with the situation)?

- > Respond to the Bazaar code 3 using lights and sirens with safe and efficient responsive driving.
- ➤ Inform other officers where you will be approaching bazaar from. This is in order to secure a perimeter with good communication, not allowing any possible suspects to escape.
- Once backup has arrived, enter the bazaar.
- > Detain any armed/possible suspect you have a reasonable reason to believe they could have been involved in the crime.
- ➤ Inform any unarmed potential bystanders to stay inside their shops until the situation is over.
- Use lethal force when necessary against active shooters.
- > This situation will be very stressful, remember to uphold code of ethics and remain professional at all times.

#### Potential Good Observations / skills demonstrated:

- > Communication
- ➤ Use Of Force
- > Professionalism
- > Perimeter setup/hold
- > Duty of care- making sure you identify suspects before using lethal force.

## **Potential Bad Observations / Misconducts:**

- > Shouting at suspects, bystanders or over radio
- > Lack of organisation
- > Poor setup/ hold of perimeter
- > Entering the Bazaar alone
- > Duty Of Care ensuring everyone's safety
- > Putting other people's lives in danger
- > Poor policy and law knowledge
