Please ensure you select a minimum of THREE ACTIVITIES across the week.

All LEAP sessions will register attendance and we will notify you of any absence. If your daughter is unable to attend her clubs for any reason, please contact the main office so that she can be removed from the list for that activity on that day. All attendance will be monitored and where students have not engaged in the LEAP programme they will be expected to attend the Intervention Week in July. LEAP options run from 3.25 pm to 4.25 pm unless otherwise stated.
