Where to manually upload your podcast Hello everyone,

I've recently seen a few posts on how to get your podcast on different audio services. For those who have a host website that doesn't automatically send your podcast to other software there's a slightly longer way to do it but still easy.

- 1. The first thing you want to do is find you RSS feed (this will be the magic link that you will be posting on other platforms)
- 2. here are the direct links to the submission page for audio platforms

<u>Amazon Music/Audible</u> (you just have to fill out the information and then wait).

<u>Apple Podcasts</u> (if you don't already have one, you will need to create an Apple Id). It might take a few days for your podcast appears on here (needs to be reviewed) Once approved, your podcast will also be uploaded to **Overcast**.

<u>Castbox</u> (you have to log in, once you do that, you just simply click and drag the file you want and then add it to an already existing channel or a new channel).

<u>Google Podcast</u> (Similar to google play music, you need to use your google account and then follow the instructions there). your podcast should be uploaded in no time.

<u>I Heart Radio</u> (you just have to fill out the information and then wait, shouldn't take to long)

<u>Pandora</u> (this is the most complex one to upload your podcast, you have to give out a lot of information in order to even be considered to have your podcast on their platform).

<u>Pocket Casts</u> (you enter your Podcast feed URL, in other words this is your RSS feed and then it should link it there).

RadioPublic (submit your RSS feed and it should upload).

Spotify (this is currently in beta but it worked well for me, it connected my RSS feed to Spotify in a few minutes)

<u>Stitcher</u> (once again, you will need an account). It might take a few days for your podcast appears on here (needs to be reviewed)

<u>Tuneln</u> (you just have to fill out the information and then wait... there's a lot of waiting when uploading RSS feeds).

RadioPublic (submit your RSS feed and it should upload).
