"What's for dinner tonight?" A question that probably sounds familiar to all of you... A question you might not have an answer to yet. Every day you try to come up with something original to make for your family. Coming home from work, needing to go to the shop, cooking, washing up, tidying, ironing... You name it.

Well, let's make things easy for you! On **Saturday, 28 March** we would like to invite you all to come and enjoy our delicious, 100% freshly made spaghetti. That day, our '**lokaal**' will serve as a picturesque little restaurant, and with a bit of luck, it will feel like a cosy little terrace.

Just like previous years, this top-quality spaghetti will be prepared by the best cooks in the land: the Sjo and +16 groups. The profit from this spaghetti will of course partly go to these groups, while another part will go towards materials for the KSA.

Because so many of you attended last year, we will again operate in two shifts. We do our best to welcome as many people as possible at the same time, but like every top restaurant, ours has limited capacity.

The **first shift** starts immediately after the activities (around **5:15 PM**): we warmly welcome parents who are coming to eat with their children. That way, you don't have to go home first and can sit down to eat right after the activities.

The **second shift** starts around **7:00 PM**: here we welcome parents who would like to stay and chat a little longer. During both shifts, we will of course also offer drinks.

The menu:

Choice between spaghetti bolognese (halal) or veggie:

Small spaghetti	[bolognese (halal)/veggie]	9 euros
Large spaghetti	[bolognese (halal)/veggie]	13 euros

Dessert (tiramisu)

3 euros

Afterwards, you can also choose a dessert. This year, the desserts are offered in collaboration with De Zoete Verleiding! This is the dessert shop of our former leader Mastan, located at Vlasmarkt 27A, 2000 Antwerp.

For people who need to leave quickly after the activities, but still want to enjoy our delicious spaghetti, we offer a **takeaway option**. Take-away can be collected during both shifts, but we do ask you to **bring your own containers**. That way, we also do our bit for the environment.

Finally, for those who stay behind: if there are leftovers after the two shifts (which is unlikely), these will be given to the people who brought their own containers.
