Why Big Brothers Big Sisters of Alaska?

<u>Big Brothers Big Sisters of Alaska</u> is a statewide nonprofit whose mission is to create and support one-to-one mentoring relationships that ignite the power and promise of youth.

We provide children facing adversity with strong and enduring, professionally supported one-to-one relationships that change their lives for the better, forever. Kids in our programs are more confident, safe, and engaged at school. Together, we empower children to realize their full potential.

Who We Serve

- 300 matches annually
- Average match length 34 months



When youth believe in themselves and what they can accomplish, they foster better relationships with friends, family, and peers, ultimately helping to create safer, stronger communities. Compared to their non-mentored peers, Littles are:

- 54% less likely to be arrested
- 57% less likely to demonstrate aggressive behavior
- 55% more likely to increase coping skills and grit

Register Online

The Big Give fundraiser will utilize the QGiv online donation platform. Getting registered is easy!

- 1. Visit our <u>website</u> and click the [**REGISTER**] tab to join. Select join a team option.
- 2. Select your fundraising goal.
- 3. Choose a photo (optional) and edit your page title with a short description.
- 4. You can edit your headline, story, emails to ask for donations, and more!

Set Your Goal

We encourage you to aim high in your fundraising goal setting! You can update the goal you set when you created your page at any time.

- **Aim high:** Set a goal that might seem like a stretch because you never know just how fast you can achieve it!
- See how much you can raise for kids: Many set a conservative fundraising goal instead of aiming high. We understand that fundraising can be a challenge but remember why you are participating for the kids!
- **Keep an eye on the competition:** If you're driven by some friendly competition, take a look at the campaign dashboard on QGiv to see if you're in the Top Teams lists.

Thank Your Donors

Remembering to thank those who support your fundraiser is an important step that you do not want to forget! Send out a short email thanking everyone who donated to your campaign page. Try to personalize your thank you note with photos!



Fundraising Tips

Fundraising is easier than you think, you just need to ask! The more you ask everyone you know, the more likely you are to get a donation of some kind. Here are some tips to help support your fundraising efforts:

- **Tell your story:** If you have a personal story of why you are participating, share it! Are you a former or current Big? A Board Member? Little? Whatever your story is, share why Big Brothers Big Sisters of Alaska is important to you!
- Identify potential supporters: One place to start is to identify a list of people who may want to support your fundraiser friends, family, neighbors, current and former colleagues, a book club or other groups you belong to, etc. Don't be afraid to think outside the box!
- **Get the word out:** Update your fundraising page, send emails (there's a <u>template</u> for that!), make calls, and/or send text messages whatever works best for each person you want to reach.
- Ask for donations through social media: Share the link to your personal fundraising page on your social media page(s). This is an easy way to capture attention and get the message out. Check out some sample posts here!
- **Share progress:** Share updates on your fundraising progress as we countdown to the deadline of April 30th!
- Share photos and videos: Photos and videos are a great way to capture the attention of those who might want to support your fundraiser. Consider sharing anything related to the campaign, including your team celebration, on social media and the Facebook event page with the hashtag #TheBigGiveAK
- Add an email signature: Consider adding a link to your fundraising page in the signature of your email, both personal and business (if this is allowed).

Award And Prize Categories

To inspire you to participate and achieve your goals, check out the Leaderboard tab so you know where you stack up against other individuals and teams. And if you find yourself at the top of the Leaderboard, you might just go home with some great prizes! No matter what, just by creating a page you get a hat!
