- 1. Welcome Rich Wills, Chairman
- 2. Review of minutes from last meeting Julie Janes, Secretary minutes reviewed and approved by council members.
- 3. Concerns from Public Facilitated by Rick Wills No concerns brought forward.
- 4. Review and approve the Land Trust Leslie Ewell reviewed the Land Trust. It was approved by those in attendance and will be sent out to council members that were not in attendance for approval.
  - a. Allocation is less because enrollment is down. This will be reviewed and allocation adjustment in October.
  - b. Goal 1 included reading interventions to have at least 70% of students making at least 1 year's growth in reading. Last year, 58.5% made 1 year's growth in reading. We are on target to meet the goal this year, and will continue with the same goal next year. Most of money will go to salaries teachers offered time to develop and refine common curriculum maps, money for peer teaching by instructional coach, Walk to read aides.
  - c. Goal 2 included strategies to have at least 70% of students make at least one year's growth in math. Last year, 58.3% of students made one year's growth in math. Using Rise testing for grades 3-6 and Acadience testing for grades K-2.
  - d. Additional funding my be used to purchase classroom technology.
- 5. TSSA review funding plan Leslie Ewell reviewed. No vote or approval needed by the council. Aligns to the Land Trust.
  - a. Wellness room is making a difference in our community.

- b. Steam Explorer Kids and teachers love it. Attendance is improved on the Fridays that Steam explorer is offered.
- c. Ride the Waves for 6<sup>th</sup> grade students.
- d. Zones of Regulation for K-5.
