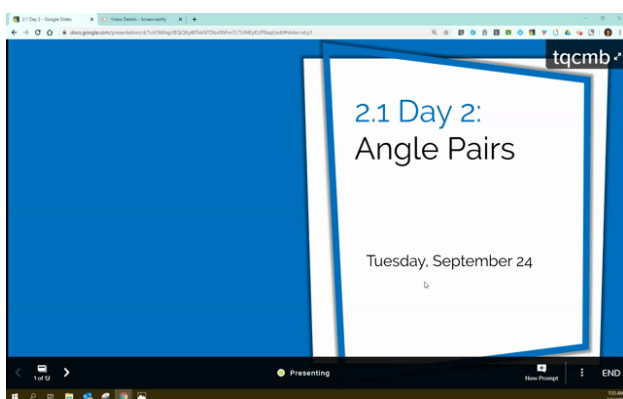


Pear Deck Student Paced

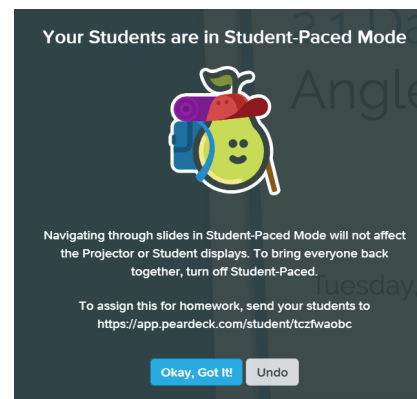
Any existing Pear Deck can be easily turned into a student-paced lesson. This allows students to work through the slides at their own pace, without the teacher leading the class. [Here](#) is a sample Student Paced lesson. Also, remember that any Google Slides deck or Powerpoint can quickly be turned into an interactive Pear Deck presentation to use in a Student Paced activity.

Step 1: In Google Slides, open the Pear-Deck add-on and click “Present Lesson.”



Step 2: Once your Pear Deck presentation is open, click the 3 dots in the bottom right corner. Then select “Turn on Student Paced”.

Step 3: You will see a screen that says “Your Students are in Student-Paced Mode” with a link to share with your students. You can share this link with students via Google Classroom or email. Your presentation will stay in this mode until you stop it. Even if you close the tab, it will remain open for students to work.
