Cap & Gown Distribution

TBD (early May) at Brunch & Lunch

Cap and gown distribution will be at Brunch & Lunch outside of the Main Building. If you miss pickup day, stop by the Counseling office beginning TBD.

Borrowed Cap & Gown Distribution

Week of May 25 at Lunch & After School

For those students that are borrowing a cap & gown, pick up will be the week of May 25 in the Admin Building. Borrowed Cap & Gowns must be returned <u>right after Graduation or on Monday, June 8th</u> in order to receive your Official Diploma. Go to the Administration Office / Front Office where you can return your borrowed Cap & Gown in exchange for your Official Diploma.

Mandatory Graduation Rehearsal

Thursday, 6/4 at 12:50 - 2:30 pm

SENIORS - report to the **Event Center** for staging. Row/Line Leader assignments will be posted inside the Event Center on the walls. Go to your assigned row and your line leader will assist in placing you in alphabetical order.

- Thursday, June 4th, students **arrive by 12:50** to check their names and proceed to their assigned section and row to check in with their staff line leaders and sit in order.
- Bring minimal personal items to rehearsal (water, sunscreen, etc.).
- Do not wear caps and gowns to rehearsal.

SENIORS - report to the **Event Center** by **4:45pm** for staging. Event Center **doors will close** at **5:15!**

- Do not bring bags, backpacks, or purses.
 - You will <u>not</u> be permitted to bring these items to the field.
 - o Leave clothes, sweatshirts, and personal hygiene supplies at home.

EXECUTION SET 1

- The ceremony starts at 6:00 pm and lasts about 90 minutes.
- The gates for bleacher and field seating will open at **4:30 pm**.
- The football gate and pool entrance will be open. The tennis court/fire lane side will NOT be opened.
 - No alcohol is permitted.
 - Water will be sold as a fundraiser for Cal Drama Boosters (cash preferred) or you may bring your own.
 - o No confetti cannons.
 - Items are subject to search.

CEREMONY TICKETS

TICKETS ARE NOT BEING ISSUED FOR THE GRADUATION CEREMONY.

FIELD / GUEST SEATING

- Seating is first come, first served.
- HOME & VISITOR bleachers and field/track seating will be available.
- **ADA-ACCESSIBLE** seating (no reservations required) will be available.
 - Please see MAP here.
 - Gates open to everyone at 4:30pm
 - Anyone needing assistance to the field can take a golf cart shuttle from the baseball field to the football stadium (before the ceremony only the crowds are too great to handle this after the ceremony)
 - Any disabled/elderly/special needs person that needs access to ADA seating, will have priority between 4:30-5:30pm to special sections
 - Their entire party *that arrives with them* may join them (within reason). If they are bringing 10+ family members, we hope that those who are able, will leave the ADA seating available to those that really need it.
 - NO seat saving in the ADA sections.

PARKING

- Parking will be available in all campus parking lots (parking map).
- **ADA-ACCESSIBLE** parking is available behind the Main Building, closest to the baseball stadium. A valid **ADA-accessible** placard and/or license plate will be required to access this parking area.
- For those that do not have an **ADA ACCESSIBLE** placard/license plate but need a closer drop-off, please let the parking attendant know so you can access the drop-off point before proceeding to the regular parking areas.
- Golf cart shuttles will be available BEFORE the ceremony for those with difficulty walking far distances. We are unable to provide shuttles after the ceremony.

- Seniors may decorate caps, but the decorations must be appropriate for school. You cannot have things sticking up off the top of your caps. Stickers, rhinestones, paint, etc. are fine.
- If you iron the robe, be very careful as they are polyester and might melt if the setting is too high.
- Get dressed up: Dresses, skirts, slacks, collared shirts, and ties are preferable to casual wear.
- High/spiked heels are not permitted as the heels will get stuck in the field (wedges are ok).
- Shoes are preferable to flip-flops.
- Please be on the lookout for a communication regarding the due dates for returning materials, such as laptops and textbooks. This will ensure you are cleared for graduation.
