
Interactive Costing Tool (iCT) Site Status Change

The following updates to the iCT were requested by a number of stakeholders across Industry, LCRN and site groups:

- The 'View Details' button is confusing
- Companies should be able to preview site costs before releasing to Site Representatives
- There needs to be the option to **remove** a Site iCT
- There should be a way to indicate when the review of site costs has been completed
- There should be a way to 'lock down' site costs but also an option to be able to amend

In response, we have developed the following:

1. A new 'Actions' column separate to the Site Costs column to make it clear what users need to do




- Previously 'View Details' would create the Site iCT and allow Site Representatives to access this at the same time
- This change now splits these two actions so that creating the Site iCT and giving Site Representatives access can be done separately
- The actions now available for Company Representatives will be:
 - Create
 - Release to Site
 - Complete

2. The ability for Company Representatives to preview site costs before releasing to Site Representatives

- Clicking 'Create' copies the Study iCT (and any open comments) as happens currently when clicking 'View Details' but the Site iCT is not automatically released to the Site Representatives
- After this, the Company Representatives can select 'View and Edit' under Site Costs to preview the Site iCT and choose whether they want to carry on with a site review and make any site specific amendments required

- Once happy to proceed, the Company Representative selects the 'Release to Site' button so Site Representatives have access to the Site iCT
- If the Company Representatives realises further amendments are required to activities at the Study-level, they can remove the Site Costs by using the bin icon and make any amendments that need to be made to the Study iCT before it is released to the site
- Site Representatives will only have the option to 'View and Edit' site costs once the Company Representative has selected 'Release to Site'


Company Representative view:




Site Representative view:




- 3. The ability to mark a Site iCT as 'Complete' to indicate that the review of the site costs has been completed
- There are two ways to mark a Site iCT as complete:
 - Select the Complete' checkbox in the Study Organisation table




Select the 'Mark Site Review Complete' when viewing the Site iCT itself.
 This will check the 'Complete' box in the Study Organisation table when you go back to the Study iCT



- This functionality is available to both Company Representatives and Site Representatives
- Once the Site iCT is marked as 'Complete', it becomes read-only to 'lock down' the site costs
- In the Site Costs column of the Study Organisations table, the link says 'View' rather than 'View and Edit' as you can no longer edit



• Within the Site iCT, the buttons to add/delete arms have been removed




 Within individual arms, the buttons to add/delete/amend Activities, Visits and Occurrences have been removed



You can still view open comments but will not be able to accept them


4. The ability to change the status of a 'Complete' Site iCT to allow it to be amended

 After marking a Site iCT 'Complete', if a Company Representative or Site Representative realise there are changes that still need to be made or comments that they want to accept, they can simply uncheck the 'Complete' box in the Study Organisations table for the Site iCT to become editable



5. The ability for Company Representatives to Delete a Site iCT at any stage of the review process

 This is done individually per Parent Organisation by clicking the bin icon next to the relevant Site iCT



• A warning pop-up will appear to confirm this decision


- A Site iCT can be deleted in any status: before or after it has been made available to the site and once it has been marked complete
- Please be aware that, upon deleting, any site specific changes (such as the
 acceptance of comments or editing of activity) already made on each Site iCT
 will be lost and could interfere with any ongoing negotiations at a site level

Benefits:

- Greater flexibility in the use of the tool
- The ability to 're-release' a Site iCT (by deleting and creating again) when an amendment is made in a Study-level iCT so that these changes will also be reflected in the Site iCT. Rather than having to update each Site iCT with the same amendment individually

Bonus:

• If the reference data necessary to calculate Indirect costs, Capacity Building and Market Forces Factor (MFF) for an Organisation are missing, an information pop-up appears



• This replaces the error page that was previously displayed that forced users to go back to the CPMS homepage

From 8th December 2021 these changes will be live in CPMS.
