Given it's the team's third game in 11 days, Jones's health is a priority for the playoffs, which could lead to him sitting out. If Jones doesn't play, Kansas City's remaining backups may struggle. The Steelers are currently 4-0 both straight up and against the spread at home with Russell Wilson as quarterback. **The public is literally split down the middle here at an even 50%.**

NFL: Baltimore Ravens @ Houston Texans - 4:30pm ET

Analysis:

The Ravens have more at stake in this Christmas Day game. While the Texans are likely secured in the No. 4 seed in the AFC, the Ravens are fighting to stay competitive in the AFC North. Baltimore recently had an impressive victory against the Steelers, whereas Houston suffered a setback with Tank Dell's injury in Week 16. Currently, the Ravens are performing at a higher level than the Texans. **The public slightly favors the Ravens on this one coming in at 52% of Baltimore to cover.**

NBA: San Antonio Spurs @ New York Knicks - 12:00pm ET

Analysis:

Last December, the Knicks had a successful Christmas, defeating the Bucks with Jalen Brunson scoring 38 points. They are currently on a strong four-game winning streak, scoring 139 points in their last game against the Raptors. Karl-Anthony Towns has been a standout, scoring over

30 points in two of the last three games. The Knicks have won nine of their last eleven games since Thanksgiving. The Spurs, while competitive this season and featuring Wemby in a national showcase, are struggling with a six-game losing streak against the spread. **The public is against us here with only 27% in favor of the knicks to cover.**

NBA: Philadelphia 76ers @ Boston Celtics - 5:00pm ET

Analysis:

Jayson Tatum may miss the Celtics' game due to illness after sitting out a loss to Orlando. The Celtics have a strong defensive record following losses, allowing just 102 points per game in their last six defeats and hitting the under in five of those. Currently, they are on a 6-0 run for the under and 10-4 in their last fourteen games since Thanksgiving. Meanwhile, the Sixers also have a solid under trend, going 13-7-1 since early November. We are heavily against the public here as 85% are in favor of the game to go over.
