

ABCD-ReproNim Course FAQs

Q: How much does it cost to participate in the ABCD-ReproNim Course?

A: Participation is free! There are no registration fees for taking part in the course.

Q: How do I register for this course?

A: Please complete an <u>ABCD-ReproNim Student Application</u>.

Q: Help! I'm having trouble registering, how do I get help?

A: If you're having trouble, please <u>send us an email</u> describing your problem in detail, including the error message, as well as information about your browser, OS, and location.

Q: I submitted a student application but I have not received a confirmation email. Did you get my application?

A: The system we use does not send out automatic confirmation emails once applications are submitted. For this reason you will not receive an email confirming your submission. However, once you <u>submit your application</u> you will see a message on your browser that says, "Your response was submitted, thank you for your interest in the ABCD-ReproNim Course!" If you see this notification on your browser window then we have successfully received your application!

Q: I recently applied to be a student in the course but I would like to change my answer to one of the questions. Can I amend my application?

A: Unfortunately there is not a way for you to amend an application once you've submitted it. However, if you <u>send us an email</u> describing your problem then we can update your application from our end.

Q: I want to apply as a TA but can I also register as a student as a backup?

A: If you would like to apply as a TA but are also enthusiastic about taking part in the course, regardless of whether or not you are selected to be a TA, then we encourage you to submit *both* a <u>TA</u> and a <u>Student</u> application!

Q: When will each week's video lectures be viewable online?

A: All videos for the main ABCD-ReproNim Course are currently online and viewable! We will be expanding the existing ABCD-ReproNim in the spring of 2022 to include a dedicated course on topics in artificial intelligence and machine learning (Al/ML). This will be a standalone event comprising five additional lecture videos and data exercises that will be available in addition to the 2022 course. We will upload videos for the Al/ML course expansion once a week starting on the week of February 28, 2021 and ending on the week of March 8, 2022.
