What are the expectations of a MHS senior?

- Continue your commitment of working hard through the last day of school.
- Complete all course credit for participation in the graduation ceremony.
- Attend school until the final bell on the last day of school, as senior skip days can impact your ability to participate in the ceremony.
- Return all school property (e.g., textbooks, Chromebooks, uniforms)
- Pay any outstanding fees, fines, or lunch accounts, prior to the graduation ceremony.
- Continue to exhibit the effort, attitude and engagement that you have been known for throughout your high school careers.
- Serve any detentions. They must be served prior to the last day for seniors or they will not be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony.
- This is a very special day for your families, for the school, and for your community. Please be very respectful of all. Be safe in these remaining days of school, and throughout the graduation weekend.

	<p>Please do not make the mistake of missing checkout items or practice, and please do not come to practice or the ceremony after consuming alcohol or after the use of illegal drugs. You will be removed from the ceremony.</p>
Did you order your cap and gown?	Graduation items were ordered earlier this year through the Jostens website. Caps and gowns will be delivered to the school and distributed by Jostens this Spring. It is suggested that you take it out of the package before the day of the ceremony to let the wrinkles settle out of the fabric.

When & where is Graduation?	Sunday, May 24, 2026, 2:00 PM, Main High School Gym
Is there a Graduation Rehearsal?	There is a mandatory graduation rehearsal on Friday, May 22 beginning at 9:00 a.m. in the main gym. Students should arrive at the school no earlier than 8:30 A.M. for final checkout. Students that are late or miss practice will not be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony.
What time should we arrive on graduation day?	Graduates need to be at MHS no later than 1:15 PM.
How Long is Graduation?	Typically graduation takes around 1 hour from start to finish.

What should graduates wear?	Caps and gowns will be red for all participants. Semi-formal attire is encouraged (e.g., slacks / dress shirt, dress, skirt / blouse, dress shoes). Wearing extremely informal attire can draw attention to an individual and take away from the ceremony. Graduates wearing altered or incorrect attire will not be allowed to participate in the ceremony.
When do students receive cords?	NHS (white) and Honor Cords (Yellow) will be given to students at the graduation rehearsal practice. If a student is an Eagle Scout and will be wearing Eagle Scout Cords or a Badger Girl and will be wearing Badger Girl Cords, they must inform Mr. Beranek prior to Friday, May 22. No other cords are permitted. <i>*NTC is no longer supporting the dual credit cords.</i>
Adornment	Students are not permitted to change or decorate their cap and gowns. Students will wear the red caps and gowns and school provided cords only. If it does not meet the required dress, or if they have altered or adorned their cap and gowns, they will not be permitted to participate in the graduation ceremony.
Where should my family park?	Parking will be available in both the front and back parking lots of school.
What entrance do we use?	Both the main entrance to the school, side entrance, and the back entrance will be open before the ceremony.
How many guests can I invite?	While there will be no limit to general seating for the ceremony (bleachers and several rows of floor seating) each graduate will receive 2 tickets for the front rows at graduation practice. It is the graduates responsibility to hang on to/share these tickets with whomever they choose. The ticket holders will need to bring these tickets with them on graduation day.

Select "Hold For Grades" in Parchment. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Be sure to change the account to your private email. If you leave your account with a school email you will be locked from your account and will need to contact Parchment directly as we do not have access to these accounts. See Ms. Aune prior to leaving school if you need assistance. For students that completed college or dual credit courses please use this link to request your college transcripts. Marathon High School DOES NOT send college transcripts. Students, if you have not already done so, make sure you save your college login and password information in case you need to access it in the future. MHS does not have access to these accounts.
