Commissions Terms of Service

TOS created with the help of heartbeats2 on FA

All commissioners must be 18 years or older for mature content(tasteful) (this includes the receiver of the commission if my service is being bought as a gift for some one else). Clean artwork has no age restriction but don't use other people's credit card or paypal without their consent.

I can and may decline a commission for any reason. If this occurs during a commission refunds will follow the refund policy seen below.

Will Do vs Won't Do

(not everything under the sun will be listed, the will's are what I would prefer(or have practice with) to do and what I have some skill or interest in, the won't is stuff that I will never do) If you see something not on here feel free to ask and I will reply as quickly as possible.

-clean sfw art
-mature art (tasteful(no genitalia))

-adult nsfw
-political
-religious
-revisions to other artists work

Payments/Refunds

-Payments will be made via Paypal upfront

-Payments will be made in USD so if you need to use the currency converter on google to find the correct amount.

Refunds will work on a total/partial basis

- -Total Refunds will occur if you have canceled before any work has occurred. You can cancel for any reason no questions asked just be quick about it, I understand life can be unpredictable and I will get back to you on a refund as fast as possible (leave 1 to 2 days as a cushion for me to see the message and send the funds).
- -Partial refunds will be based in quarters (25%) based on how far in the commission I am when cancelled (100% roughs, 75% refined sketch, 50% linework and flats, 25% Final shading and edits).
 - -Upon cancellation the commissioner will receive the refund based on what point was reached and the current state of the image.

-Once I get to your commission in the que I will message you on DA/FA/Telegram for a Paypal info to send a request on Paypal.

Commission Selection

-(Added 5/6/20) Added to help possible commissioners understand what goes into my selection of commissions.

-Commissions are selected on an "interest" base

- -interest is boosted more by how well a possible commissioner briefs me on what they want and less on what type of character or number of characters. (The more it feels like a story is being told in an image the better chances of selection you have)
- -This does not mean that you have to write paragraphs worth of story as a brief, but think about what would lead up to the event, and what the consequences of the event would be (this especially helps for images with backgrounds because it helps me plan out a background that helps tell a narrative rather than just slapping a character on a generic background)
- -this is still good practice for non background commissions because it helps me visualize how you want a character to look and feel.

Queue

- -The que is just a wait list for interested parties.
- -NO payment will be asked for until I have gotten to your commission.
- -I will pick and choose order, if your commission is not picked it will be moved to the waitlist which will be completed after all the main que slots are complete.
- -If you find that you cannot afford a commission but have been selected for a que slot, you may request to be moved from the que to the end of the waitlist to wait until a time where you may have more money.

 -If the wait list does not have as many people as there are slots after all the main que commissions are complete, I will open commissions again and the remaining wait list commissions will be moved to the

top of the que and all the new commissions will be shuffled into the remaining que and waitlist slots.

- Due to time constraints a majority of the work time I have for this type of stuff is on the weekends because my week is filled with other obligations. While I will try and do some work during the week I can not promise anything.(THIS POINT IS ONLY RELEVANT DURING SCHOOL SEMESTERS)
 - -Commissions can take from one week to one month(although unlikely) to complete depending on complexity.
 - -Have some patience, life can get in the way just as easily as it can for you.
- -Messages can be sent either via FurAffinity, Deviantart, Telegram, or via Email (if you noticed that I have read a message but not responded please give me some time to respond, sometimes I am out and seeing the message on my phone and in no real place to respond).
 - -I will either respond the day of or next day to messages from commissioners.

Sticker Queue Rules

-(Updated 3/25/21)

- Sticker queues are separate from normal queues so please keep an eye out for which type of queue you are signing up for
- -each sticker commission form can acquire up to 10 stickers (you do not have to get 10 stickers in a batch, you just have the option to go up to 10)
 - -each sticker can include up to 2+ characters (limited by the size of the sticker)
- -Sticker commission forms will not be accepted as normal commission forms and vice versa (picking up a sticker commission means you will get a sticker commission, you cannot later decide you want to change it to a normal illustration slot)
- -sfw and nsfw prices vary (updated prices will always be on the price sheet)
 -nsfw is anything that can be defined as having mature or adult content, having exposed genitals is not the only thing that can make a sticker nsfw (inclusion of kink gear, dildos, latex, cum etc will make an sticker

nsfw)

-if you are looking for nsfw stickers please read the separate TOS on my nsfw account.
-please be descriptive with sticker briefs (not asking for a complete rundown of how each pose or expression should be down to a science, more just looking to avoid "character X happy/character X sad"
-A good example of how to fill out the individual sticker briefs would be, "Character X, wearing clothes/accessories Y, happily drinking a cup of coffee." (this gives me all the info I need to know as it tells me how many characters are in the sticker, which character is in the sticker, what a character is wearing (if anything), what emotion is being portrayed by the character, and what that character should be
