Julia Krone grew up and was educated in Cape Town, South Africa. At the University of Cape Town, she gained a Social Science Honours degree, and a First-Class distinction in Community Development Work. For four years she studied painting at the Edinburgh College of Art, now Edinburgh University. Julia is an experienced and pioneering event manager and jazz singer. But painting and drawing have always been her passion. She moved from Johannesburg to Edinburgh via Malta in 2007. The family's Georgian flat in Stockbridge became a popular official Edinburgh Fringe Festival venue for art exhibitions, and she continues to open her home studio by appointment throughout the year. A collection of her work is housed at the Institute of Directors (IoD) in Edinburgh. Her paintings, prints and soft furnishings may be found in private collections in South Africa, France, Spain, Australia, USA, Peru, Uruguay, UAE, Cayman Islands, England, Wales, and Scotland.
