STEP	INSTRUCTIONS
THE DAY BEFORE THE MEETING	Make a copy of this Bible Study Googledoc for your group. Make it editable. Post the link to the googledoc in the chat for everyone. Explained: How to make an editable copy of your Bible Study Googledoc. Look over the notes. Come up with a personal story. Ask God to help people encounter Jesus.
WELCOME	We are gathering to encounter Jesus together. We assume God is always moving in us and around us no matter where we are or what circumstance we are in.
WARM-UP	Ask an engaging question to get people talking: Has anyone ever made a major sacrifice for you that surprised you? (or have you?)
PRAY	Invite someone to open in prayer.
READ THE PASSAGE AND ADD COMMENTS	Invite someone in the group to read the story aloud.
	After reading, ask everyone to use the comment button to note their observations and questions about the passage.
DISCUSS Help everyone discuss the story. Be directive. If there are long pauses then call on specific people to answer.	The younger son demands his inheritance while his dad is still alive. How does he view his dad? When he hits rock bottom, he wants to return home, but as a servant. How might a servant get treated? What do you like about how the father responds to his son?
	THE DAY BEFORE THE MEETING WELCOME WARM-UP PRAY READ THE PASSAGE AND ADD COMMENTS DISCUSS Help everyone discuss the story. Be directive. If there are long pauses then call on specific people to

	EXTRA QUESTIONS (if you have time)	Who do you identify with more—the son who runs away, or the sonwho stays? In what way? Try this—Close your eyes and imagine yourself in this scene. What do you want to say to the father? What would he say to you? Give yourself a minute to play it out in your mind. (After a minute, ask if anyone would like to share what they imagined).

4 min	MAKE IT PERSONAL Tell a story from your life.	Tell the story of your own spiritual journey back to the Father's house. How did you experience God's love and choose to follow Jesus? How has your life been different since? Better yet, coach someone else in the Encounter Group to share their story!
5 min	APPLICATION 1: SPIRITUAL INVITATION Share the Big Story and make an invitation to follow Jesus! Make sure you practice this in advance. Share the link so everyone can follow along together. When everyone has it pulled up then read it outloud. Plan what you'll say if no one responds or if someone does. If no one responds say something like, "Thanks everyone for listening and responding honestly . I'm glad we can have honest conversations about what it means to followJesus." If someone does respond say, "Thanks for taking a risk and sharing honestly that you are ready to put your trust in Jesus! I'd love to pray and thank God for your new faith.
