- Marysville Little League will use the Official Little League Volunteer Application form to screen all of our volunteers.
- Coaches Clinic / Fundamentals Training:
 - Coaches Clinic – TBA – Recommended to all managers/coaches. Clinic will be held at BASE By Pros facility in Lynnwood WA
- Rules Fundamentals Training – will be covered by league officers during coaches meetings prior to the start of the season. At least one manager/coach from each team must attend training

- First Aid & CPR Training:
 - Recommended for all managers/coaches
- Concussion Awareness and Sudden Cardiac Arrest Training:
 - Required for all managers/coaches

- All coaches/managers will be required to walk/inspect the playing field prior to practices and games. Umpires will also be required to walk the fields for hazards before each game

- Marysville Little League has completed and updated our 2020 Facility Survey on-line
- Concession Stand Safety
 - Menu for any/all stands shall be posted & approved by the Safety Officer and League President. Our concession stand procedures will be posted several times/locations within each concession stand
- A valid Snohomish County Food Handler's Permit will be required of at least one person working in any time in any concession stand serving hot food as required by the Snohomish County Health District



ASAP Plan Page 6

- The League Safety Officer and Equipment Manager will inspect all equipment in the pre-season
 - Managers/coaches will inspect equipment prior to each game
 - Umpires will inspect equipment prior to each game
- Implement Prompt Accident Reporting
 - The League will use the Little League Baseball and Softball Accident Notification Form) from the LL website and will provide completed accident forms to Safety Officer within 24-48 hours of the incident:

ASAP Plan Page 7

- Each team that travels or plays in inter-league play will be issued an updated First Aid Kit and is a requirement to have it at every practice and game
- For all teams that do not travel or inter-league, first aid kits will be stocked and provided at each field location in the equipment lockers with the field equipment
- Marysville Little League will require ALL TEAMS to enforce ALL Little League Rules including:
 - Proper equipment for catchers
 - No on-deck batters
 - Coaches will not warm up pitchers
 - Bases will disengage on all fields
