- Jonathan Harris for Commissioner Natalie Hall - BOC meeting tomorrow (6/21) at 10am and special call meeting at 2pm. 141 Pryor Street. Couple of updates from Commissioner Hall:
  - In the process of getting ready for monthly cleanup. ### Item One – Public Safety

- APD Zone 6 & Fire Station 10 Update
  - Lt. Capell – Zone 6 Day Watch Commander; can be reached at [ntcapell@atlantaga.gov](mailto:ntcapell@atlantaga.gov). His updates include:

- Down 12% in crime in the past 28 days. The precinct has auto theft deterrent devices for Hyundai and KIA owners.
    - ACE Unit got a new commander, and has been very active in the 605 space and bordering zone of Zone 3. Zone 3 is south and west of Grant Park.
  - Lt. Crosby - Zone 6 Morning Watch Commander 9pm to 7am; can be contacted at [rcrosby@atlantaga.gov](mailto:rcrosby@atlantaga.gov).
  - One neighbor raised concerns about gunshots occurring on Boulevard near the CVS between 9-midnight, occurring frequently.
  - 6 officers getting better speed detection training this week, so there should be additional resources to monitor speed on Boulevard

## Item Two – Land Use & Zoning

- Z-22-22 - Ordinance to Remove Parking Minimums for All Zones in BeltLine Overlay
  - NPU-W LUZ voted Unanimously to Support on condition that residential parking minimums remain for now
  - This is due to BeltLine residential development currently being tied to erasing parking minimums as an affordability incentive
  - Addressing Parking Maximums is also recommended to be of equal importance
  - A motion was held to vote on this ordinance; there was a lot of discussion with neighbors around historic preservation and implications. Neighbors decided to defer to the GPNA LUZ committee. - Z-22-23 - Ordinance to Prohibit New Drive-Thru & Drive-In Uses in BeltLine Overlay
  - NPU-W LUZ voted Unanimously to Support on condition Pharmacy Drive-Thru Uses remain allowed for purposes of retrieving prescriptions
- Z-22-24 - Ordinance to Prohibit New Service Station Uses in BeltLine Overlay
  - NPU-W LUZ voted Unanimously to Support with no added conditions
- The Beltline overlay district is on aver  $\frac{1}{3}$  to a  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile from the physical Beltline
