The electronic publications are only allowed to use, if those are published by a competent source, such as journal and government private institution, and the accessed date should be put after the last sentence.

Acknowledgement (if any) to person(s) or institution(s) who help the research should be stated (e.g., research grant provider, etc.).

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Reference arranged alphabetically based on the last name of the first author. References with the same name of the authors (group of authors) are listed chronologically. If there is more than one author (group of authors) which publish in the same year, thus the letters a, b, or c, should be added after the year. The composition of literature sources must contain of scientific journals/scientific magazines not less than 70% of total references.

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
