<b>Enrollment</b>	High school enrollment through course selection	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>High school enrollment through course selection</li> <li>Completion of enrollment at Dallas College</li> <li>May require Dual credit TSIA documentation</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>High school enrollment through course selection</li> <li>If a passing grade is not earned in 1<sup>st</sup> semester, it may require a qualifying TSIA2 or SAT score to regain eligibility to earn college credit for the year</li> </ul>
<b>CCMR Impact</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students who earn a 3 + on the AP exam earn the CCMR indicator</li> <li>AP exams or classes do not meet the TSI college-ready standard</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students who take and pass 1 math class or 1 English class earn the CCMR indicator and can earn a TSIA waiver</li> <li>Students who earn 9 hours of dual credit (3 classes) earn the CCMR indicator</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students who are eligible to earn credit earn the CCMR indicator</li> </ul>
