

The soon-to-be relaunched website Juicy Pink Box is seeking pitches for its **Culture** and **Confessions** verticals and story submissions for its **Erotic Fiction** section. All pitches and submissions should be sent to submissions@juicypinkbox.com.

What is Juicy Pink Box?

A hub of everything sexy — think a modern take on Nerve.com or The Cut if New York Magazine had a pay-gated XXX section. We're creating content that's both smart and smutty; with stories that give women new perspectives on sexuality and desire, as well as hot videos, audio, and writing to titillate and turn them on.

Juicy Pink Box loves:

- **Diverse Perspectives:** We want to see pitches and stories that are inclusive of varying ethnicities, nationalities, races, genders, sexual orientations, ages, abilities, and body types, that approach sexuality and eroticism with authenticity and depth.
- **Inclusivity:** We encourage submissions that challenge traditional narratives and offer new perspectives, promoting equity and inclusion in journalism and erotic storytelling.
- **Unique Voices and Perspectives:** We are particularly interested in pitches and stories from writers who identify as part of marginalized communities, including but not limited to LGBTQIA+, BIPOC, disabled, and neurodivergent individuals.

What are the Culture and Confessions verticals?

The Culture vertical is a space for writers to explore art, culture, and lifestyle writing with a sexy edge. Essays about the books and movies that led to your sexual awakening. Recommendations for songs to set the mood. Reviews of art that explores sexuality and identity. Culture pieces don't have to be titillating in and of themselves, but they should have some connection to sexuality, romance, or related topics.

The Confessions vertical is more straightforward: we're looking for stories about real-life sexual experiences (and yes, they can be anonymous). Want to tell people about your first time at a sex party? What it's like to explore a kink? How you finally had your first orgasm? We're all ears.

What kind of Erotic Fiction are you looking for?

The Erotic Fiction section features well-crafted stories that combine compelling characters, engaging plots, and sensual eroticism. All sub-genres are welcome, including contemporary, historical, fantasy, sci-fi, and paranormal. Stories can be stand-alone or part of a series, at 950-1000 words per story, but each story should be at least 50% sex or "intimate"/erotic moments.

Additionally, please note that while Juicy Pink Box errs on the side of being more open and liberal and accepts content that many other platforms do not, we do not accept content that is illegal. Examples of content we do not accept: rape, sex involving minors, bestiality, voyeurism where the person being watched is unaware and non-consenting, revenge porn, human trafficking (note, however, that stories about and by empowered sex workers with agency are allowed), and incest (however, step-relatives are allowed).

What does it pay?

We have a flexible pay scale, paying between \$0.10-\$0.50/word depending on your experience. These pay rates are for non-exclusive license grant — you retain ultimate ownership of your work. If erotic fiction writers consent to have their stories adapted as an audio piece, they will receive a second fee equivalent to the initial rate.

Are you looking for a specific writing style?

A Juicy Pink Box piece should be smart, thoughtful, and sexually curious; and should expand readers' worldviews and share a new perspective without ever talking down to them. Some samples of pieces we love from other publications are below.
