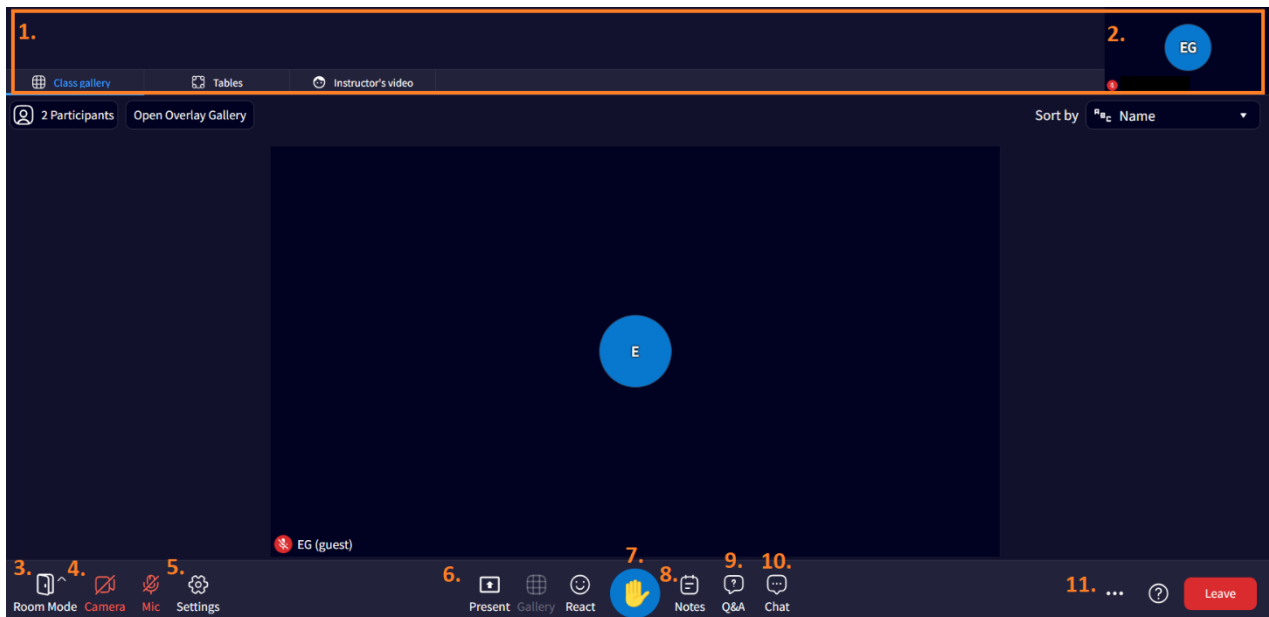


Engageli Platform Overview for Learners

This article will provide an overview of Engageli from the learner perspective.

Note: When a student first joins a tutoring session, the student will see a prompt to use the Engageli “app.” Students should click on “No” to proceed.

Gallery View



1. **Podium:** When students raise their hand, their video will appear on the podium, and the whole group will be able to hear and see them.
2. **Instructor's Video**
3. **Classroom Mode:** Instructors determine the classroom mode. In the Gallery View, learners will be in Room Audio Mode; in the Tables View, learners will be in Table Mode.
4. **Camera and Microphone:** Learners can turn the camera and microphone on and off by selecting these buttons. If the icon is green, then the device is on; if the icon is red, then the device is off.
5. **Settings:** This button opens the Settings window, where learners can adjust their audio and video sources, add a virtual background, change the platform's appearance, and activate accessibility features.
6. **Present:** This button allows learners to share their screen with the group (Gallery View) or table (Tables View). If learners want to share their screen with the group, they must receive permission from their instructor.

7. **Raise Hand:** This button will “raise” the learner’s hand and automatically move them to the podium..
8. **Notes:** This button will open the Notes panel on the right side.
9. **Q&A:** This button will open the Q&A panel on the right side, where learners can post questions (anonymously or with their name attached), answer questions that others have posted, and download question threads from any session.
10. **Chat:** This button will open the Chat panel on the right side. Learners can use the Chat to send direct messages. They can also upload documents to the Chat and download the Chat history.
11. **More Actions menu:** This menu provides access to various settings and tools, such as **Low Bandwidth Mode**, which optimizes the Engageli platform experience for learners with limited internet access or CPU.
