Peer Tutor Guidelines and Expectations

Thank you for your interest in becoming a student peer tutor at Scott High School! As a student peer tutor, you will be expected to act as a role model for other students within both the classroom and the school building as a whole. As a role model, it is important that peer tutors are self disciplined, responsible, organized, respectful, patient, and punctual. If these descriptors apply to you, then you are exactly the person we are looking for!

As a student peer tutor at Scott, you may be asked to do the following:

- Assist students with their class work (NOT just telling them the answers, teaching the skills or giving examples so that they are able to complete the work on their own)
- Guide students on classroom behavior (Set a good example for the underclassmen and students you are working with.)
- Read and/or write for particular students
- Respect peer confidentiality
- Work with students on motor skills
- Assist students with community and employability skills
- Assist students with daily living skills
- Data collection
- Other assignments and/or activities deemed appropriate by supervising teacher

As a student peer tutor at Scott, you will be expected to do the following:

- Serve as a role model to others
- Take initiative to assist both teacher and students in the classroom to enhance student learning
- Follow instructions (stay in the room you are assigned, etc.)
- Be polite and well mannered at all times
- Maintain the confidentiality of the students whom you work with!

Note: Students may not be a Peer Tutor for more than one class period per trimester. Students may not be a Teacher Aide or Office Aide and a Peer Tutor in the same trimester.
