    - The lesson will be observed by a few members of the interview committee.
    - Student feedback will be collected and reviewed.
- Final Months
  - Transition events occur to familiarize students with PVRS and teachers.

# Regarding the letter from DESE sent on February 22, 2021:

It is important to point out that this letter is specific to the work done that led to the School Committee voting on the 6th grade move. The original process that began January of 2020 was interrupted by the pandemic. Due to this, the original process that PVRSD had put into place was not completed prior to the School Committee voting on the move. On November 12th of 2020, PVRSD administration was asked by the school committee to complete a detailed plan for their review. At that point the following steps were taken:

- On November 16th 2020, the 6th Grade Reconfiguration Committee reconvined.
  - Present; Amy Boyden-parent, Karen ONeil-School Committee, Kristen Gonzalez-School Committee, Melissa Gerry-parent, Michael Townsley-School Committee, Matt Soycher-PVRS School Counselor, Brian Campell-middle school english teacher, Renee Keir-teacher.

- On December 10th, 2020 this plan was presented to the School Committee. DESE is most interested in:
  - The educational impact on all of the students, focus on 6th grade
    - Curriculum was addressed in the Reconfiguration Planning Document
    - The Grade 6th Curriculum Committee will be following through with a more thorough look into the impact, advantages and disadvantages.
    - This committee will be led by the Curriculum Coordinator who will work with administration and content specific teachers to ensure alignment of the curriculum.
  - The financial impact to the district and member towns
    - The financial impact was reviewed during the budget process, documented in the provided plan and reviewed to the School Committee via the power point presentation.
    - The 6th Grade PVRS Committee is responsible for looking into the financial impact including but not limited to:
      - Title one funding, transportation costs, curriculum costs, building modifications, special education, staffing changes, etc...
  - The outreach that has taken place involves parents, students and community members.
    - Besides the outreach that has already taken place, the plan provided specifies that the School Committee will be updated on a regular basis once the 6th Grade PVRS Committee begins its work on June 18th.

 The 6th Grade PVRS Committee is responsible for gathering the information from the sub committees and determining how to share the information publicly.
