Program requirements for the OALA Aspiring Administrator Leadership Program:

1. Fill out [online application](#) .
2. Protégés must be CURRENT members of OALA. The application process is competitive and priority will be given to OALA members who have demonstrated contributions to the organization and its mission.
3. Protégés must be Latino, have three years of teaching experience, and have prior leadership experience.
4. Proteges must be currently enrolled into an administrator program. The program is specifically designed to increase the success of Latino Aspiring Administrators.
5. Protege must set up a meeting to discuss with their district, the commitments required.
6. A 1-year commitment is expected of all participants, May 2019-May 2020.
7. When possible, the committee will attempt to match participants geographically. However, when not possible, mentors and protégés are expected to travel to meet regularly.
8. A non-refundable protégé participation fee is due at the beginning of each participation year. Fees correspond with the size of your supervising district:
 - Above 10,000 students = \$1,000
 - Below 10,000 students = \$500

It is the proteges responsibility to inform their district of the financial obligation.

9. Protégés are required to attend and stay overnight at the following cohort meetings:

10. Protégés will meet with mentors at minimum of 10 times throughout the year.
11. Protégés will be expected to submit monthly electronic mentoring logs to program facilitators.
12. During the year, it is recommended that the protégé attend the following activities:
 - Participate/observe a Cabinet level meeting
 - Attend a school board meeting
 - Attend/observe a District level staff meeting
 - Attend additional conferences, professional meeting and workshops, when possible.

I understand the level of commitment necessary to participate as a protege. I agree to attend all of the mandatory dates and trainings. I will ensure that I have time and the support from my district for the OALA Aspiring Administrator Leadership Program from May 2019 to May 2020.
