Initial and Final Consonant Blends

What is consonant blend?

Consonant blend is made up of two or more consonants found next to each other and blended to make distinct consonant sounds. Blends are found either at the beginning or at the final part of a word.

What is the initial consonant blend?

Initial consonant blend is a blend found at the beginning of a word.

Examples:

Words: **cl**ap, **fr**og, **br**ead, **tw**in

Phrases: a **gr**een leaf a funny **cl**own
the **bl**ue water a big **cr**ab

Sentences: The **bl**ack cat **pl**ays with me a lot.
We use the **pl**ain **bl**anket of my mother.

What is the final consonant blend?

Final consonant blend is a blend found at the end of a word.

Examples:

Words: salt**lf**, wolf**lf**, hand, lamp**mp**

Phrases: a small desk**sk** a long text**xt**
my bank**nk** deposit the food cart**rt**

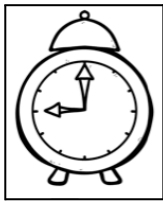
Sentences: My mil**lk** spilled in the sin**nk**.

Daddy wears a gold belt.

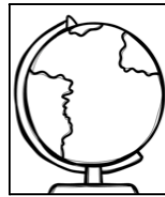
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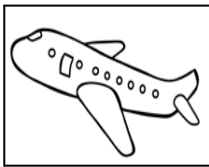
