COURSE OBJECTIVES:

To introduce students to the **Elements of Art and Principles of Design** while developing drawing skills and painting techniques. Studio experiences in the classroom will give students opportunities to experience a variety of media while developing student's individual style and creative problem solving skills. Students will demonstrate their ability to respond, to analyze, and to interpret their own artwork and the work of others through discussions, critiques, and writings.

ATTENDANCE:

SKETCHBOOKS:

An artist isn't made overnight. Daily practice is needed to hone drawing skills and improve. Students will complete drawing tasks several days a week for Bellringer assignments.

GRADING:

40% - Studio Work/Assessments: Long term assignments that take several days or weeks to complete.

60% - Sketchbook/Classwork Tasks: Assignments that are completed in less than 2 days.

CELL PHONES/MUSIC PLAYERS/CHROMEBOOKS:

No cellphones, music players, or headphones/earbuds will be permitted for use during class. **Chromebooks** may be allowed during specified class time for **digital assignments or research purposes only.** During this time, students will have explicit directions that must be followed in order to use technology. 5. Referral to administration


IN THE CLASSROOM/SCHOOL:
